## Instructions for Using PhotoAuto Maps

The best way to use the Photo-Aluto Maps is to follow the route by the topographical map and refer to the photographs only to make sure that you are turning at the right place. Use your meter at all times to get the distances between turns. The distances given between turns will vary with different machines, as a slight difference in size of tires, different conditions of the roads and many other things tend to vary the register. Three meters were used and an average taken to get the distances given. The numbers in the squares and circles give the number of the photographs at the turns and the figures outside of them give the distance to the next photograph. The compass on each plate should be used to get correct directions. This map is not drawn to scale, but is made to show the turns to the best adrantage. Where turns occur close together the map is enlarged and where there is a long straight run it is condensed, so do not judge distances by the appearances of the map. Go entirely by the meter readings. Distances between closest points only are given to insure the smallest rariation. The distances given are the average obtained from three different makes of speedometers and a re-checi: by the Warner Auto- Meter.
