

GENERAL ORDERS, No. 210. WAR DEPARTMENT, ADJUTANT GENERAL'S OFFICE, Washington, December 18, 1862

By the direction of the President, the troops in the Department of the Tennessee, and those of the Department of the Missouri, operating on the Mississippi river, will be divided into four Army Corps, to be numbered the Thirteenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, and Seventeenth.

Major General J. A. McCLERNAND is assigned to the command of the Thirteenth Army Corps;

Major General W. T. SHERMAN to the command of the Fifteenth Army Corps;

Major General S. A. HURLBUT to the command of the Sixteenth Army Corps; and

Major General J. B. McPHERSON to the command of the Seventeenth Army Corps.
