 TOECA 84 indicates some misinterpretation on 85904. No intention in W 85904 to alter any existing ECA/K functions or chief of mission's prerogatives. W 85904 outlines procedures for handling assistance of kind which may be offered ROK by members of UN other than US. That such assistance and procedures be strictly supplemental to ECA assistance and established ECA procedures. ECA/K would be expected to coordinate ECA procurement with UNCOK in order to avoid duplication supplies, but ECA/K procurement would in no way be delayed. ECA/Korea's function in connection UN supplies would be, as stated W 85904 Para 3, to act as executive agent in Korea for reception and distribution of relief supplies provided by other UN countries."

Report No. 2. *57836* This is TORCA No. *79* Subject: Shipping

Part 1: Re RCATO 42 will report as changes occur. One weekly will report commodities in storage and all known incoming cargoes.

Part 2: MSTS desires ECA arrange own shipping Japan-Korea using Japanese vessels for approved procurement recurrent-movement commodities such as coal. SCAP will control clearance such vessels on same basis as MSTS vessels. One trial shipment coal being arranged by FSS. If satisfactory MSTS will cancel existing charters five vessels now used this service effective July 21. MSTS advises will bill ECA/Tokyo on Form 1080 for services to that date.

Part 3: Lykes indicate reimbursement will be requested for crew bonus, war risk insurance, diversion cost, demurrage and extra steaming time on vessels diverted Keelung when not scheduled that port. Other lines indicate similar charges contemplated except crew bonus not mentioned. Settlement contemplated Washington level. No difficulty anticipated availability or restriction on clearance shipping from Japanese ports to areas other than Korea.

Part 4: Vessel or cargo changes. SS Empire State: 5 boxes general consisted of parts purchased by Gilbert Associates. Shipped to Nagasaki for Jacona.

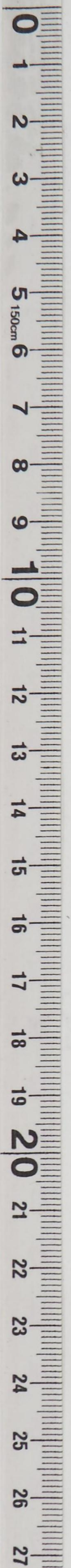

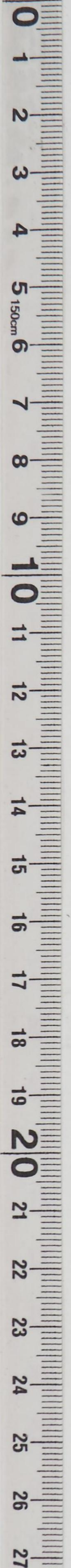

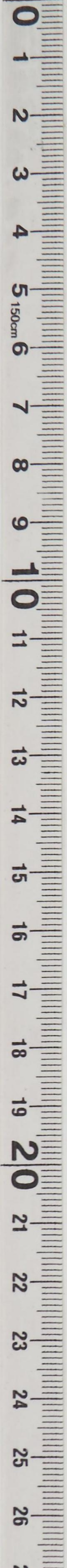

Following listed employees on basis of reasons outlined below would seem to have qualifications valuable during emergency or immediately after mission returns Korea. If there are specific reasons for return these employees we would appreciate your advising us. Appears here George Manley would be useful current emergency in connection food distribution Korea. Services Dayton Kirkham would appear have utility in connection restoration devastated areas. Upon return Korea, Charles Taylor and Laurence Cartland should be helpful in restoration facilities and necessary improvisations to get textile production started. Appears Mildred Barody could now be of assistance in dealing with public health problems and working with refugees in view extensive acquaintance Korean public health facilities, personnel and problems. Marine engineers Ernest Kroner, Abe Pfenning, Albert Willis should be able provide valuable service in present emergency situation. Experience Robert Dyer, a senior Naval Captain familiar with port operations, should be useful now. Also experience Manuel Ogas, communications specialist, appears useful in light of continued reports of faulty communications handicapping military operations. We would like to suggest further that it might be desirable to reconsider decision return James B McKinley to US in view apparent need for communications specialists.

Please advise specific circumstances or reasons warranting return any of above personnel to US.
