### Introduction.

Confronted with the <sup>serious</sup> ~~great~~ decisive <sup>stage of the great</sup> war between Japan and the United States, we, the Japanese, must smash the enemy, the United States in armed, <sup>we</sup> production and psychological wars with our best. It is not too much to say that the future of the Greater East Asia War depends upon the result of this decisive war. The enemy, the United States is the largest and greatest old foe. It is impossible to ~~expect~~ expect self-independence of our country and co-prosperity of the Greater East Asian nations of one thousand million unless we annihilate the United States. But while intending <sup>to</sup> overthrow ~~of~~ Japan and conquer ~~of~~ Greater East Asia with imperialistic aggressive potential, united strengths of resources, capital and production, the United States is devoted herself in terrible war propaganda,

exhibited an invisible aggressive strength, propaganda strength. This propaganda strength of the United States is an accompaniment of American ambition of controlling over ~~the~~ the entire world and is a march of ~~her~~ plot of ~~controlling~~ East Asia. It, <sup>is</sup> continued to strive <sup>internally</sup> to exalt the ~~the~~ fighting spirit of the American mass, and externally to conciliate neutral powers and to ~~collapse~~ lead the internal fronts of ~~the~~ belligerent powers into collapse.

Now, in attacking upon the United States, we must get a win at any cost in this propaganda, <sup>warfare</sup> in order to win armed, production <sup>we</sup> and psychological wars. As you know well in the real example of the World War I, if ~~you~~ you want to win war and to secure <sup>the</sup> peace, you must, first of all, win the propaganda warfare. The United States is the most powerful propaganda country. This propaganda <sup>strength</sup> of the United States is ~~an invisible weapon~~ the most terrible and hateful, invisible weapon to control over the world. Therefore, it is the urgent business for us to expose the skillful war propaganda <sup>strength</sup> of the United States and to smash her intention of invasion.

I stayed in the United States in the most historical and important period for two years before the outbreak of this war. Through my experiences and observations for her propaganda <sup>strength</sup> I ~~wrote~~

Since then, as severe war situation <sup>has</sup> become, hatred feelings of the Americans against Japan have been serious and their brutal character has been exhibited at every place. According to Zurich telegram, some of American soldiers sent bones of Japanese soldiers to their homeland as souvenir or sent paper knife made of bones of Japanese soldier died in the Pacific to Rossett. These cruel actions are splendid sports for Yankys soldiers and every day occurrences for Yanky people. burnt with revengeful feeling.

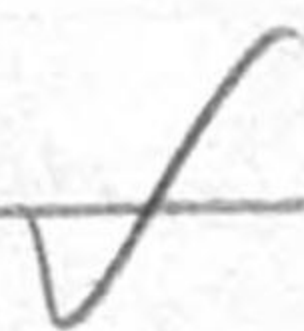
