Men and women across America have helped to build the systems to support NASA's missions to the Moon, Mars, and beyond. Companies from every state in America have contributed to NASA's Artemis program, helping to establish a sustainable human presence at the Moon.

NASA Prime Contractors Aerojet Rocketdyne, Boeing, Jacobs, Lockheed Martin, Northrop Grumman and nearly 4,000 suppliers are helping to build the Orion spacecraft, the Space Launch System rocket,

and Exploration Ground Systems capabilities to modernize the Kennedy Space Center spaceport.

This endeavor reaches beyond the United States to NASA's European Space Agency's (ESA) partners. ESA and its European suppliers are outfitting the Orion spacecraft's service module for Artemis I and subsequent flights. These missions are critical to the space economy, fueling new industries and technologies, supporting job growth, and furthering the demand for a highly skilled workforce.
