Detection

Planned work:

- AbuseFilter performance management, usability, and functionality improvements
- Anti-spoof improvements to pertinent tools
- Features that surface content vandalism, edit warring, stalking, and harassing language to wiki administrators and staff



Reporting

Planned work:

- An evaluation of existing reporting systems, starting with English Wikipedia's AN/I
- A new harassment reporting system that doesn't place the burden of proof on or further alienate victims of harassment.



Evaluation

Planned work:

- The User Interaction History tool.
- A private documentation system for admins to take notes.
- A dashboard for admins to manage current investigations and disciplinary actions.
- Cross-wiki tools to manage harassment cases across wiki projects and languages.



Blocking

Planned work:

- Per-page and per-category blocks to enforce topic bans
- ‘Mute’ features for individual users to control their on-wiki and email communication
- Global CheckUser tool improvements
- Sockpuppet blocking tools
