

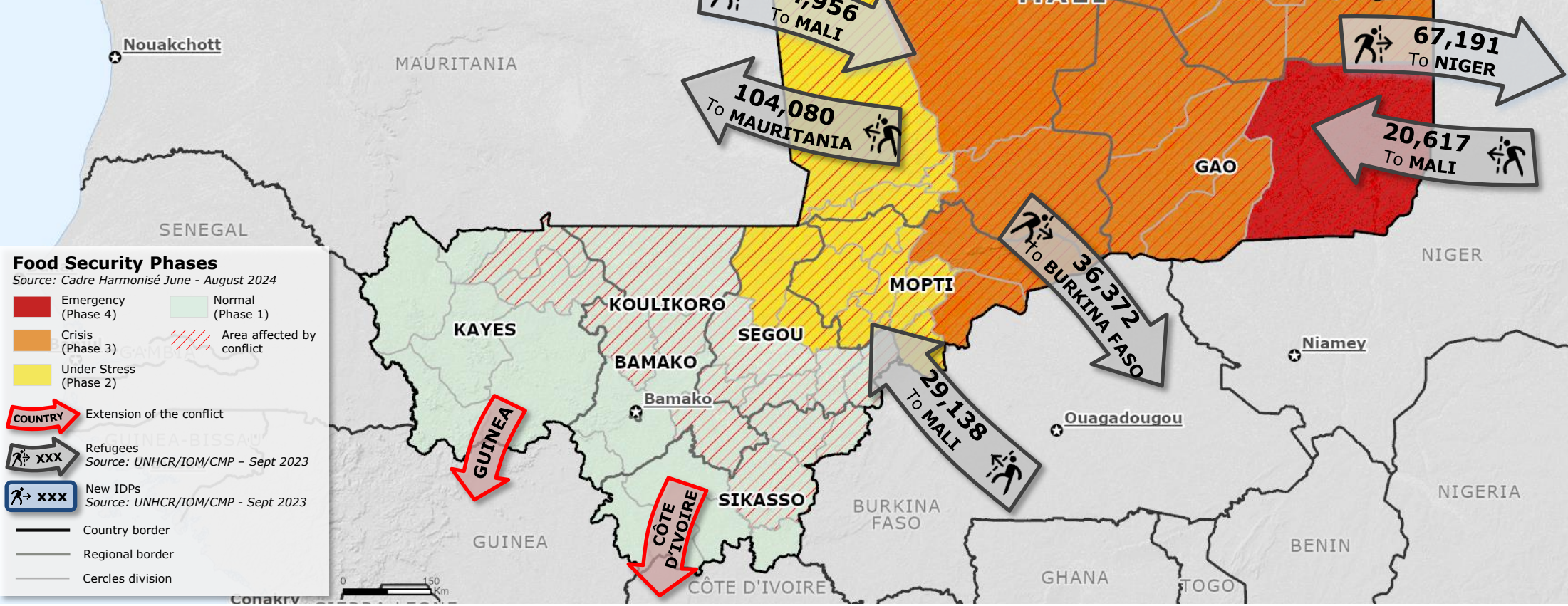
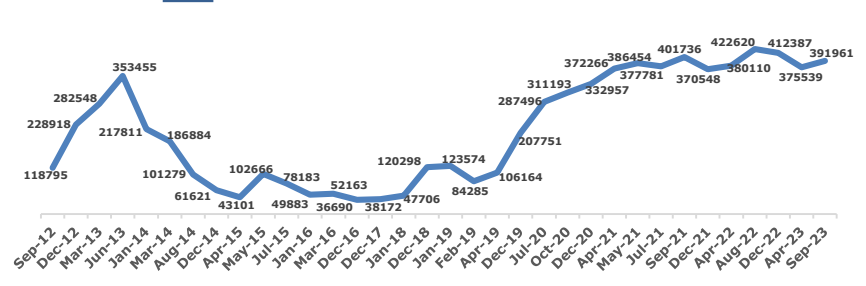
# Mali Humanitarian Crisis - August 2023

<b>1,372,224</b>	People at risk of food crisis during the lean season June-August 2024 (phase 3-5, Cadre Harmonisé November 2023)
<b>275,665</b>	Children under 5 at risk of Severe Acute Malnutrition in 2023
<b>207,870</b>	Malian refugees in Burkina Faso, Niger and Mauritania

**1,550 school closed (17%)** affecting some 465 000 children and 9 300 teachers. Affected regions: Mopti, Menaka, Gao, Kidal, Timbuktu, Segou, Koulikoro and Sikasso.

**21% of health centers are not functional** in the North and Centre due to insecurity and lack of health staff
