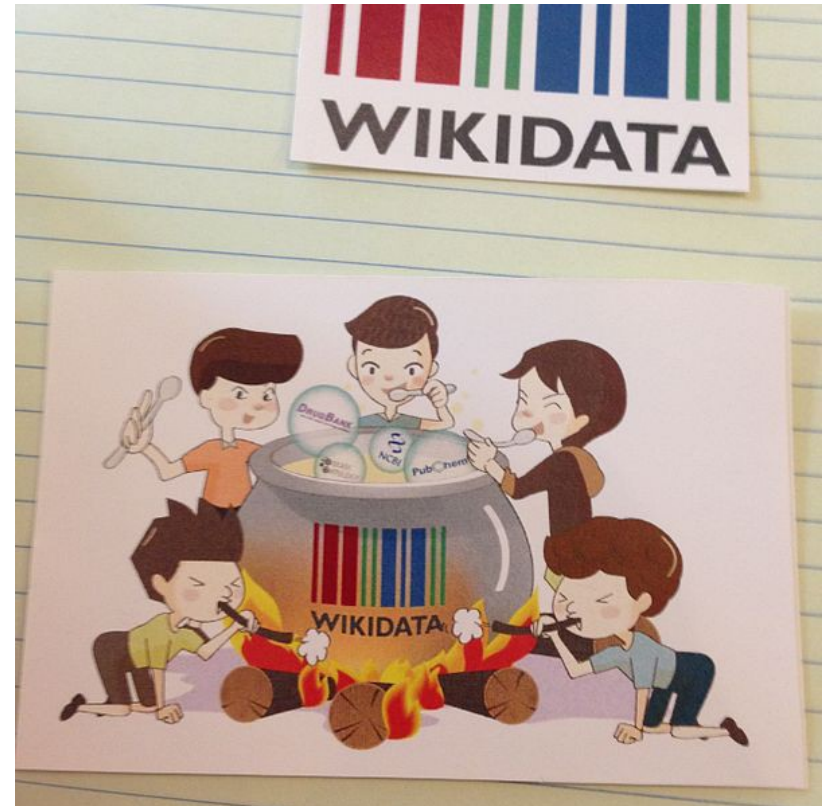

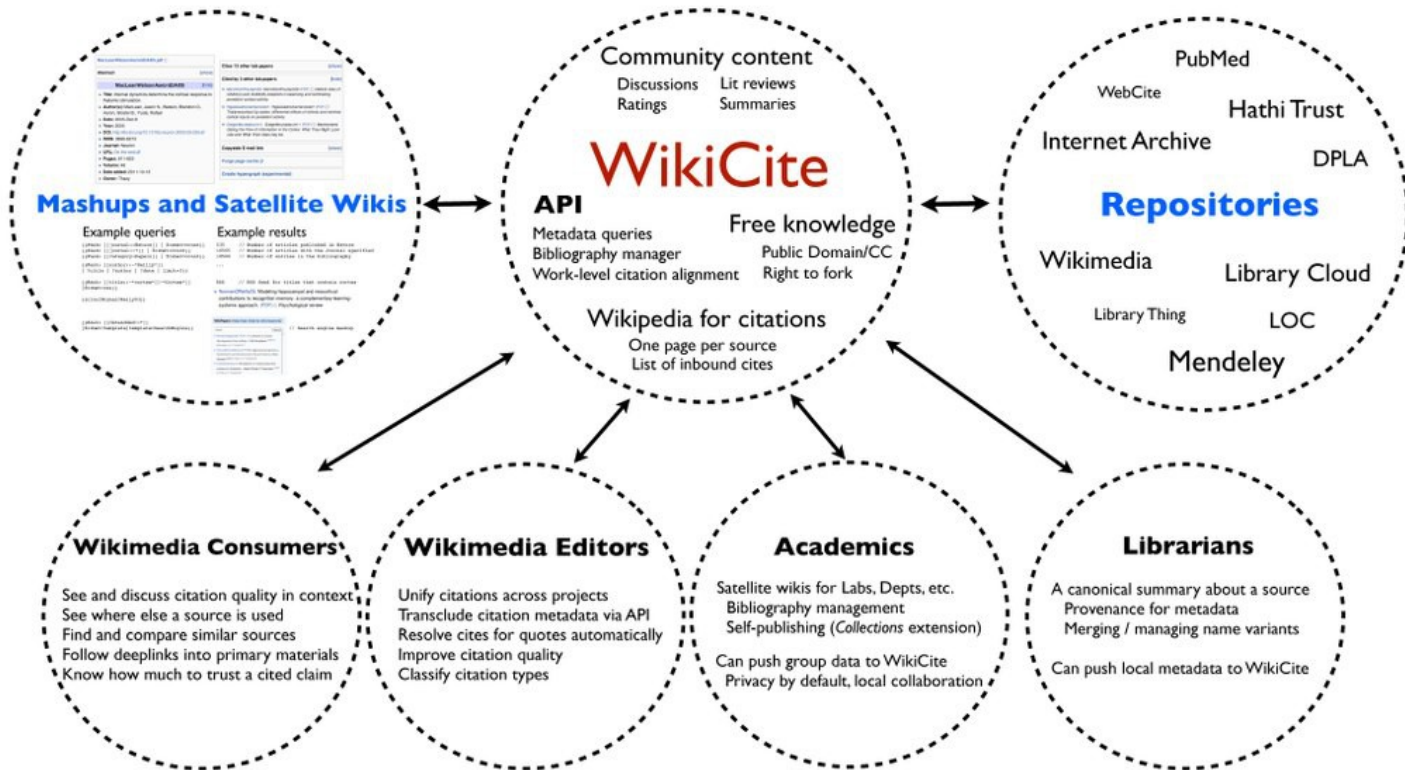

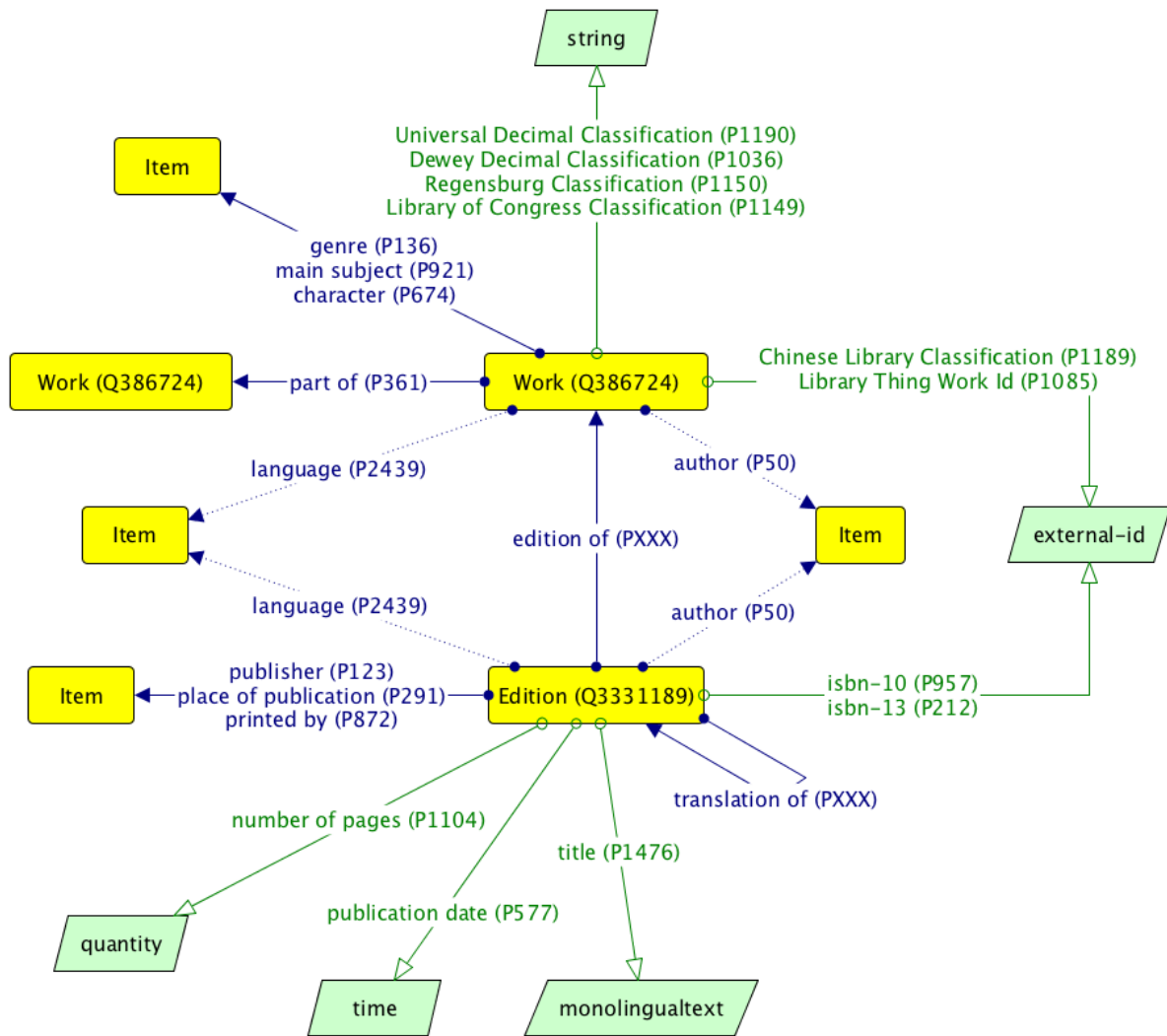


It is hard to know where to go today to discuss and document source reliability. For example, Wikipedia's 20+ million articles contain citations to millions of individual sources. Yet there is no standard way to discover and comment on source quality and context, leaving users in the dark about the reliability of cited information. WikiCite proposes to address this gap by building a wiki platform with one page per cited source, and tools to help researchers cite, find and visualize sources and related data.

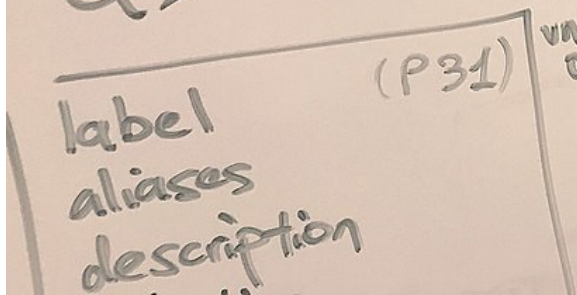

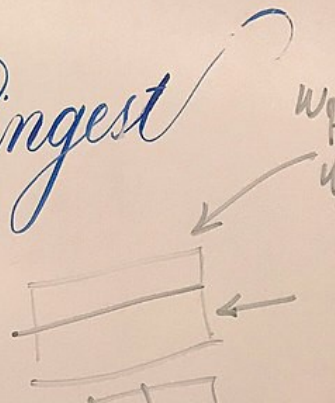
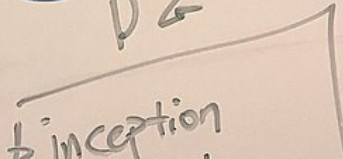
