Adam Forepaugh, the veteran circus manager, died Thursday at Philadelphia, Pa., at the age of sixty-eight. Mr. Forepaugh many years ago embarked in the circus business, in which he was very successful, getting together the most extensive circus and menagerie, with which he amassed a fortune which is estimated at more than a million dollars.
