Stated that Commandant Henri Picq, French Assist. MILATT to Egypt, who has been in inelligence work for 15 years, heads the French Intelligence Service for entire ME, and spends large sums of money on acquisition of industrial information. Subj claims that he personally knows French Intelligence Headquarters personnel and stated he could furnish this office with organizational and funct onal information of the Demxime Bureau. Subj stated that lathough the French outwardly cooperate with the Western nowers, unofficially they are always working for themselves, and in certain instances actually against the interest of the West. Subj stated that while in France, thru other intelligence contacts, he was able to see all French Intelligence reports on the CERVA Company. French have complete information on production, employees, salaries, etc.

Subject recently discussed the problems he was having as Director

In discussion 25 June with Subj, Subj, reported that there is a 3 way cleavage IR-189-55 in the Ministries of War, Production and Commerce and Industry. 

1. Ing. Rolf Engel, born in Mct2 on 10 August 1912, a German space and guided missile research specialist working for the Italian government organization Sispre, is much interested in a joint rocket development program to be undertaken by Germany, Italy, and France. He came to West Germany about ten days before the NATO Conference in December 1957, with an Italian general apparently to discuss with the West German Defense Ministry a program by which the three countries could cooperate on rocket developmental work to avoid duplication of research and eventually to develop standardized rockets for the use of the NATO countries. One of the Germans who participated in the conference was Dipl. Ing. Ludwig Boelkow, head of the Boelkow Corporation of Stuttgart, with whom Engel has been in touch on another joint program. According to an associate of Boelkow, no joint work has yet been undertaken by the three countries, but plans to organize the developmental program are under consideration.

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- 2. During World War II, Engel headed a solid-fuel research and development center in the Danzig area under the German government. His team was later moved to a development center near Pribran, in the vicinity of Prague, and toward the end of the war to Munich, where it continued working until the American occupation of the area. At this point, Engel moved to the French Zone of Germany for a short time and in 1947 went to Paris to work for ONERA, a French government organization concerned with rocket development. He employed German technicians for some of his ballistic and trajectory work there.
- 3. In 1952, Engel accepted a job with the Egyptian government and moved to Cairo, where he remained until the summer of 1957. In Egypt, as in Paris, he employed a number of German engineers and technicians, some of whom came from Paris with him. Engel left Cairo in July 1957 to take a position with Sispre.

UPSWING's @MAUKER in personal contact with Rolf Engel, a specialist in rocket and space engineering, who worked on rockets for the Wermacht in WWII and subsequently engaged in rocket research and production in France, Egypt and Italy. In both Egypt and Italy he worked in close cooperation with the armed forces.

UPSWING interest stems from derogatory information developed on Engel's family. Apparently, his mother-in-law and brother-in-law are both Communists and the mother-in-law allegedly accepted intelligence missions from the SED. Additionally his parents-in-law are divorced but continue to live together. The father-in-law is a free lance scientist and has been associated with Engel in various scientific projects in the past.

At the time EGLA 25209 was prepared, it is possible that UPEWING had not decided to reveal its operational interest in Engel.

- 1. Graduate engineer (Dipl. Ing.) Rolf Engel worked in the field of rockets and guided missiles at Peeneminde during World War II. After the war he worked with other German rocket specialists for the French S.N.E.C.M.A. organization. Subsequently he went to Egypt to work with other Germans on the development of rockets of the "Veronica" type. In mid-1961, during a visit to Germany, Engel was approached by unidentified Israeli agents and advised to discontinue his work in Egypt because the continued rocket production in the UAR would result in an armed conflict with Israel. Engel thereupon cabled his wife in Cairo to join him in West Germany immediately. The Engels did not return to Egypt, and left all their possessions there.
- As of early 1963 Engel was engaged in development work on the "Cobra" antitank rocket, a joint project of Ludwig Bölkow K.G., Munich, and Contraves A.G., Zurich.

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
