

Entry for 17 February 1945 states Jap-Army Hdqtrs on 10 Feb issued orders to puhish all Filipines net pro-Japanese and reports that several thousand civilians were killed.

Until yesterday we lived in the hills or in fishing barries and we had only salt to go with our rice. But today we are in Paradise. There is nothing that we cannot obtain. Although there were a tremendous number of watches, rings, suits, shoes and dresses, we couldn't take them back with us, and so we had to burn them with great regret. Everyone has 3,000 or more passes in cash, We had all we wanted of good things to cat.
