

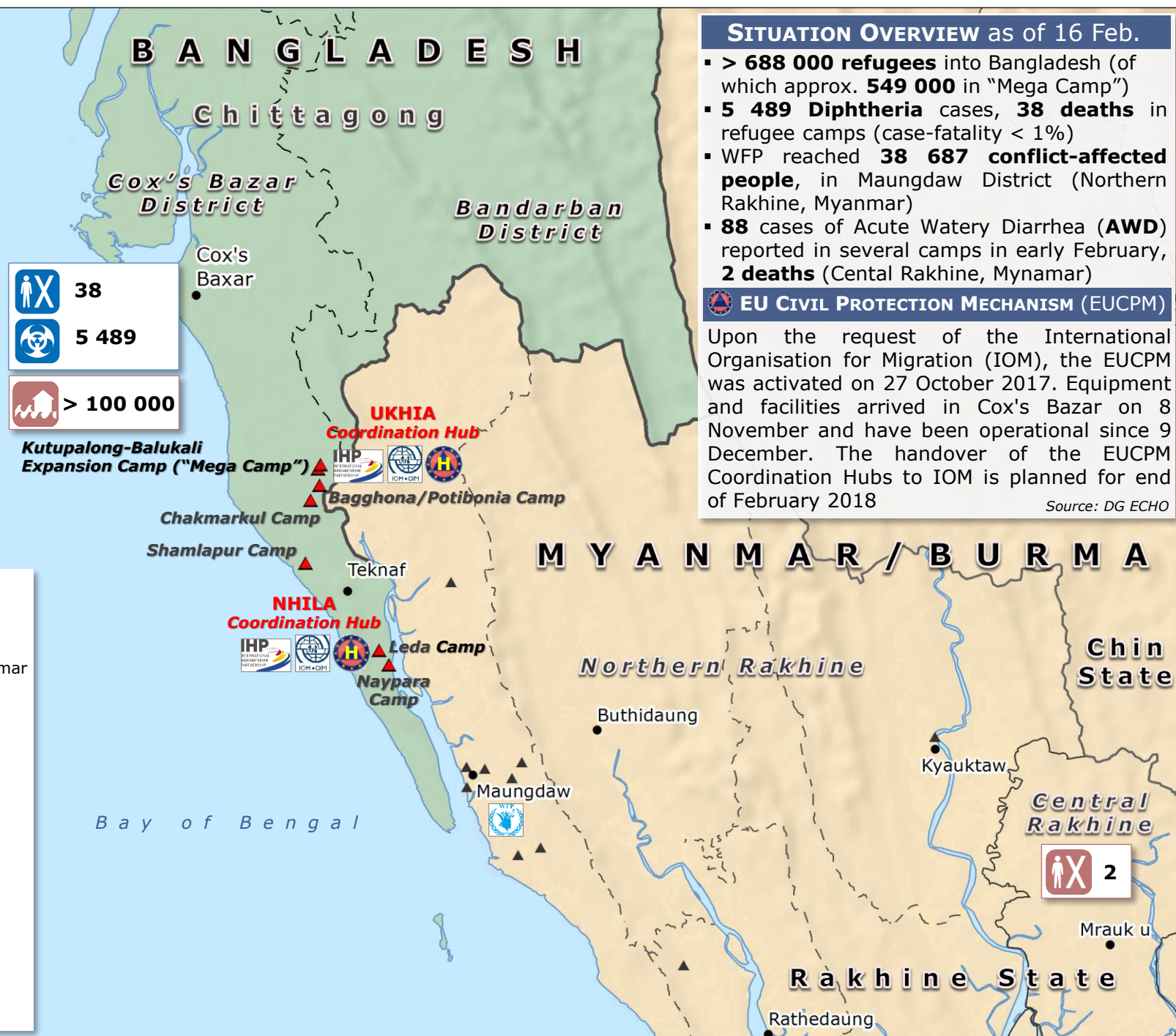
**SITUATION OVERVIEW** as of 16 Feb.

- **> 688 000 refugees** into Bangladesh (of which approx. **549 000** in "Mega Camp")
- **5 489 Diphtheria** cases, **38 deaths** in refugee camps (case-fatality < 1%)
- WFP reached **38 687 conflict-affected people**, in Maungdaw District (Northern Rakhine, Myanmar)
- **88** cases of Acute Watery Diarrhea (**AWD**) reported in several camps in early February, **2 deaths** (Cental Rakhine, Mynamar)

**EU CIVIL PROTECTION MECHANISM (EUCPM)**

Upon the request of the International Organisation for Migration (IOM), the EUCPM was activated on 27 October 2017. Equipment and facilities arrived in Cox's Bazar on 8 November and have been operational since 9 December. The handover of the EUCPM Coordination Hubs to IOM is planned for end of February 2018
