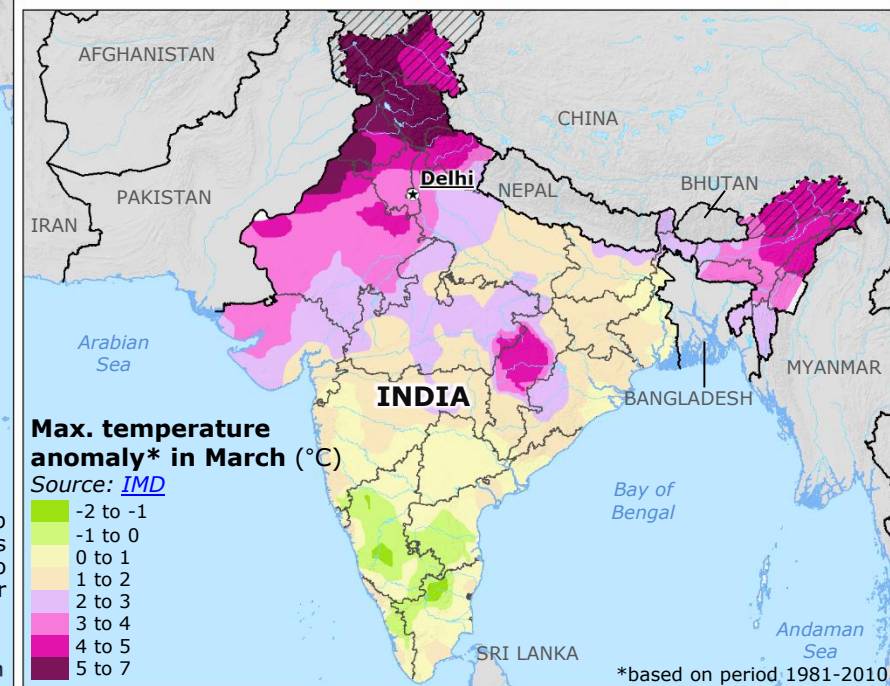
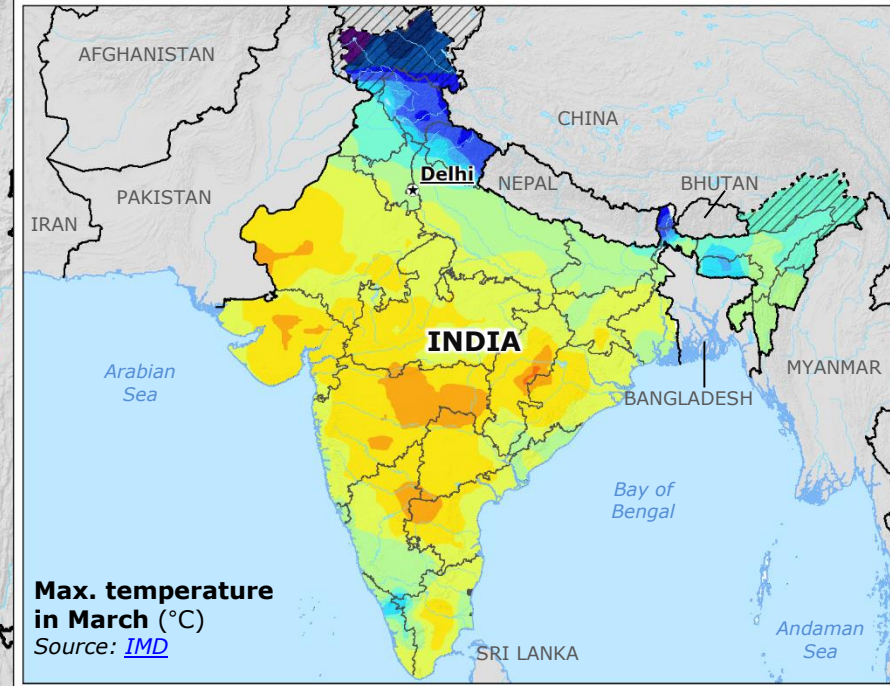
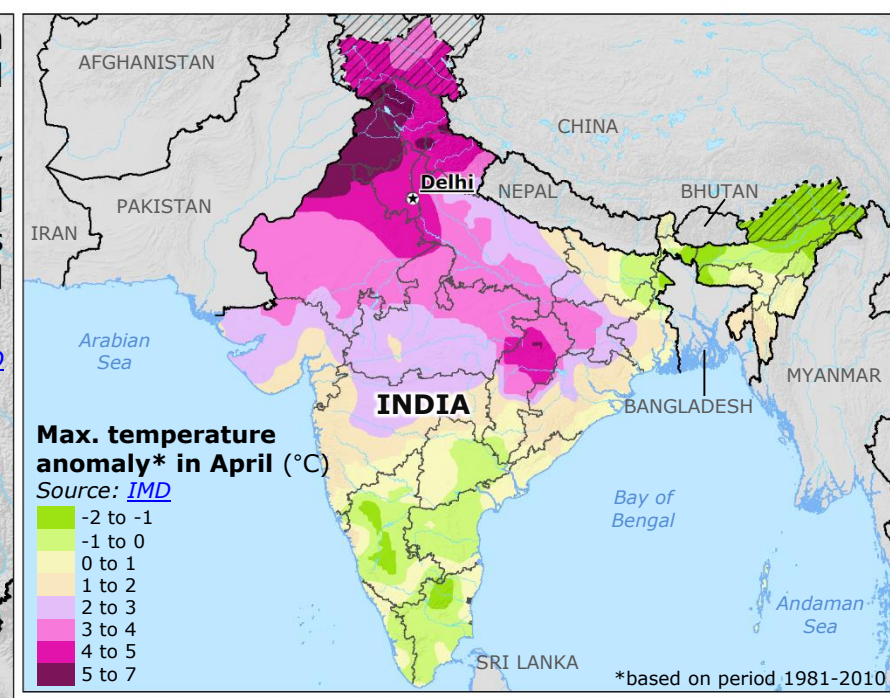
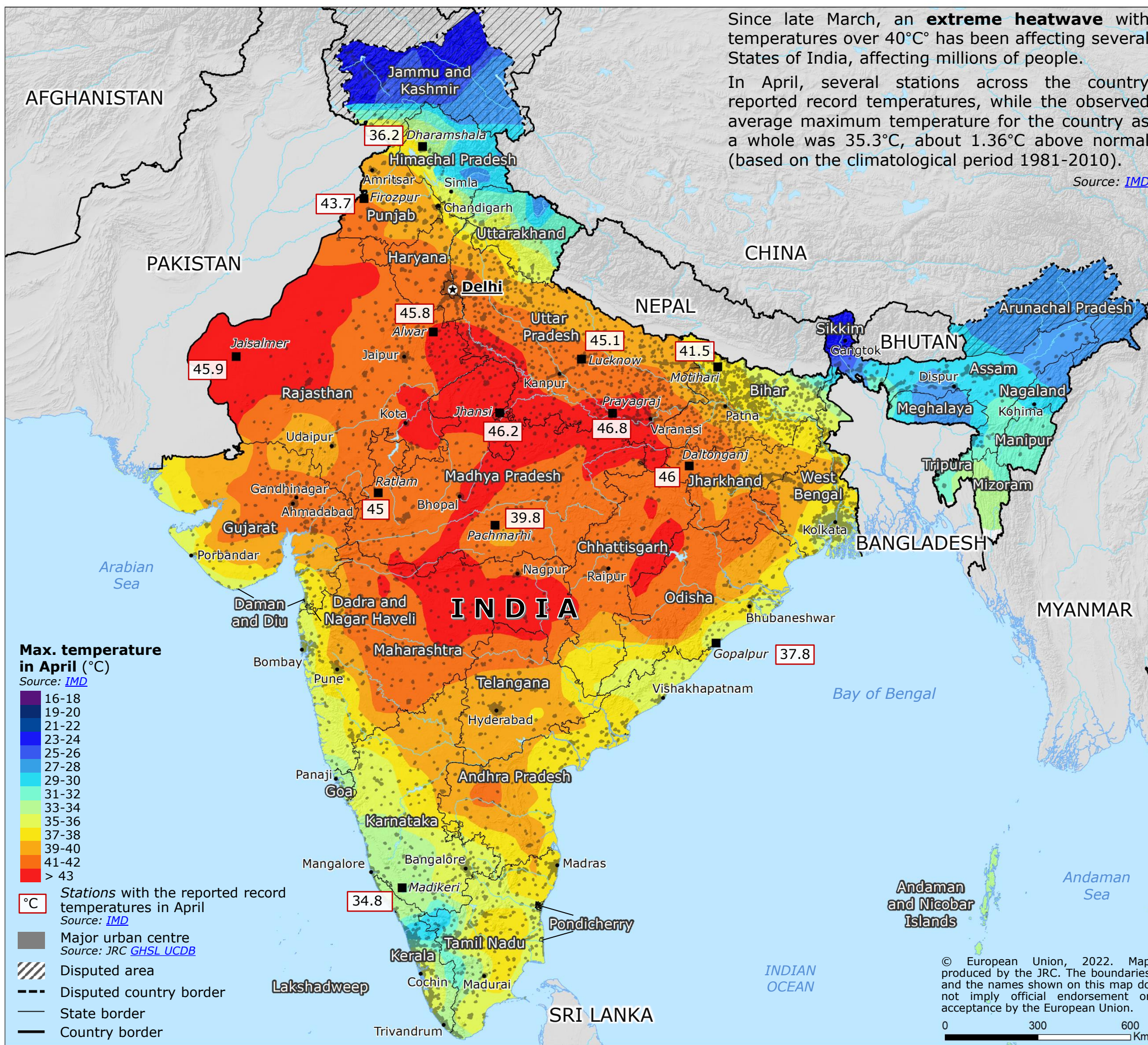


# India | Heatwave

Since late March, an **extreme heatwave** with temperatures over 40°C has been affecting several States of India, affecting millions of people.

In April, several stations across the country reported record temperatures, while the observed average maximum temperature for the country as a whole was 35.3°C, about 1.36°C above normal (based on the climatological period 1981-2010).
