d. Nature of dispute: All of the 14 day labors who had been employed by Construction Sect., Uwajima City Office for public works were discharged as of 30 Apr., 1950. The reason was that the public works for 1950 fiscal year was suspended for the time being as the works were not approved by the Construction Ministry. But the City Office employed 54 day labors as they thought they could re-start the works. 6 moderate members of the above Union composed of 14 members were re-employed through good offices of PESO. Several leaders of the Union applied to us as a case violating Art. 7 of the Labor Union Law since the City Office apparently took exception to the Union as these leaders of the Union were not re-employed and 3 of the 6 members re-employed were those who seceded from the Union.
