MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Submission of Monthly Labor Report

1. References:

2. References 1a and b are rescinded.

3. The Japanese Government will prepare and submit the following certified data for each of the forty-six (46) Japanese prefectures, for each month beginning with January 1948, and each month thereafter:

a. Actual number of workers furnished to the Allied Forces on Labor Requisition from the first through the last day of the month.

b. Actual number of workers furnished to the Allied Forces on Procurement Demand from the first through the last day of the month.

c. Total amount of cash wages actually paid by the Japanese Government to the laborers supplied to the Allied Forces on Labor Requisition from the first through the last day of the month.

d. Total amount of cash wages actually paid by the Japanese Government to the laborers supplied to the Allied Forces on Procurement Demand from the first through the last day of the month.

e. Estimated value of wages in kind, such as food, furnished by the Japanese Government, without cost, to laborers working for the Allied Forces on Labor Requisition from the first through the last day of the month.

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f. Estimated value of wages in kind, such as food, furnished by the Japanese Government, without cost, to laborers working for the Allied Forces on Procurement Demand from the first through the last day of the month.

4. On each report shall appear the actual breakdown of each item of data detailed in paragraph 3 above that should be charged to:
