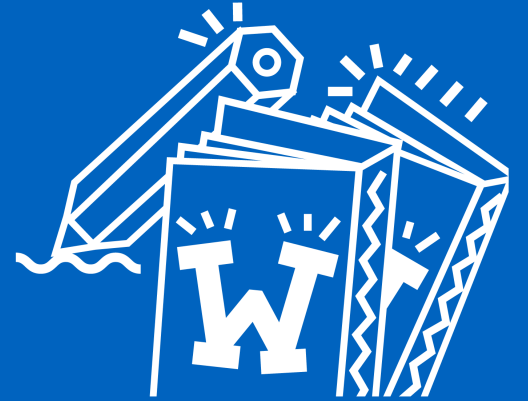

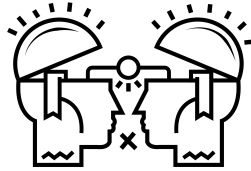

3 Reasons for Wikipedia 101



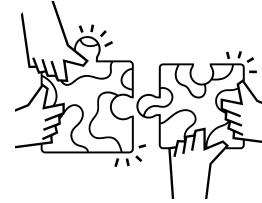
1. Sustainability

After the training programs, users can find answers to their questions and continue their Wikipedia edits.



2. Peer Learning

To deliver the same quality educational content over the internet to those who cannot access physical education programs. Thus, to ensure peer learning.



3. Collaboration

The project was co-created by widely distant Wikimedia communities. Thus, they got to know each other and a good example of a cooperation project was formed.
