

Article of Agreement made this 13th day
May 1830 between Benjamin Newman
of Reading Neben County New York of the
1st Part and Elijah Quincy and J. J. Deuel
of Waterloo Seneca County N.Y. of the 2^d Part
Said Newman agrees to Furnish all the tim-
ber ready Framed and delivred on the
bank of the Canal in this vilage for
a Building 40 feet wide 80 feet Long &
18 feet Posts and apist in Raising the
Building all of which is to be of good sound
Timber and framed in a workmanlike
manner when the building is raised the
said Quincy & Deuel agree to pay said
Newman four Cents per foot running
measure for all the Hewed & Sawed timber
contained in said Building which is to
be according to a certain Plan delivred
to said Newman. One Hundred Dollars
to be paid when the Timber is to delivred
and the ballance on the 1st November next
Said Newman further agrees to Inclose the
Building for Seventy five Cents for Every Square
of Ten feet and board. In witness whereoff
