I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant forwarding the undernoted plans, in triplicate, of Water Tube Boiler proposed by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd. for a replace boiler for the above vessel.

Plan No. 3238/114 - Details of Steam Drum. Plan No. 3238/115 - Details of Pads and Nozzles.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb per sq. inch, provided the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

It is concluded that the safety valves are to be adjusted to limit the pressure to 120 lb per sq. inch as in the case of the original boiler, although the scantlings of the replace boiler are suitable for a working pressure of 200 lb per sq. inch as stated above.
