 3. July, 1945 We had trial production of the materials for steel propeller blades.
 4. 20th July, 1945 The plant was bombed by the air-raid. The plant remained without operation from this time till the termination of the war.
 5. 16th August, 1945 After the termination of the war the plant closed as it is.

6. 11th Oct., 1946

We received the Custody Directive as the air-craft plant.

7. 1st July, 1949

According to the permission of the plan for the reconstruction and adjustment of enterprise, the Secondary Company New Fuse Metal Industries Ltd. - was established and our company was dissolved. Now we are going into liquidation.





As it has stopped its operation totally, number of employees were cut off to the minimum necessary only to work the adjustment office

and the maintenance. And it was a great effort and difficulty that we have paid for the maintenance and guard over the whole, vast designated area.

However, the absolutely necessary area for the maintenance of the reparation-designated equipments is only A zone shown in red on the attached map. There are no reparation machines installed in B, C, D zones. They are not the zones directly necessary for maintenance. So we should like to have exemption of B, C, D zones not so much necessary in order to carry on faithfully maintenance job without qualin and with minimum personnel, from designation and to put stress on A zone, concentrating the whole energy on security and guard. As stated in the application, C zone is expected for the purchase due to the Independent Farmer Origination Special Law, and D zone, if the exemption is permitted, is understood to be sold to Toyama City by the Japanese Government.

2. Buildings.

No. 3 (Map No. 11) and No. 4 (Map No. 12) warehouses have not a single reparation equipment. They are located in D area and now quite idle. We should like to have them sold to Toyama City in order to utilize them for the New System High School Buildings, and exempting them from designation, to diminish guard areas and at the same time to strengthen guarding other buildings.
