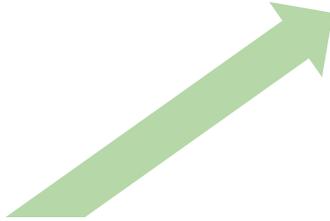

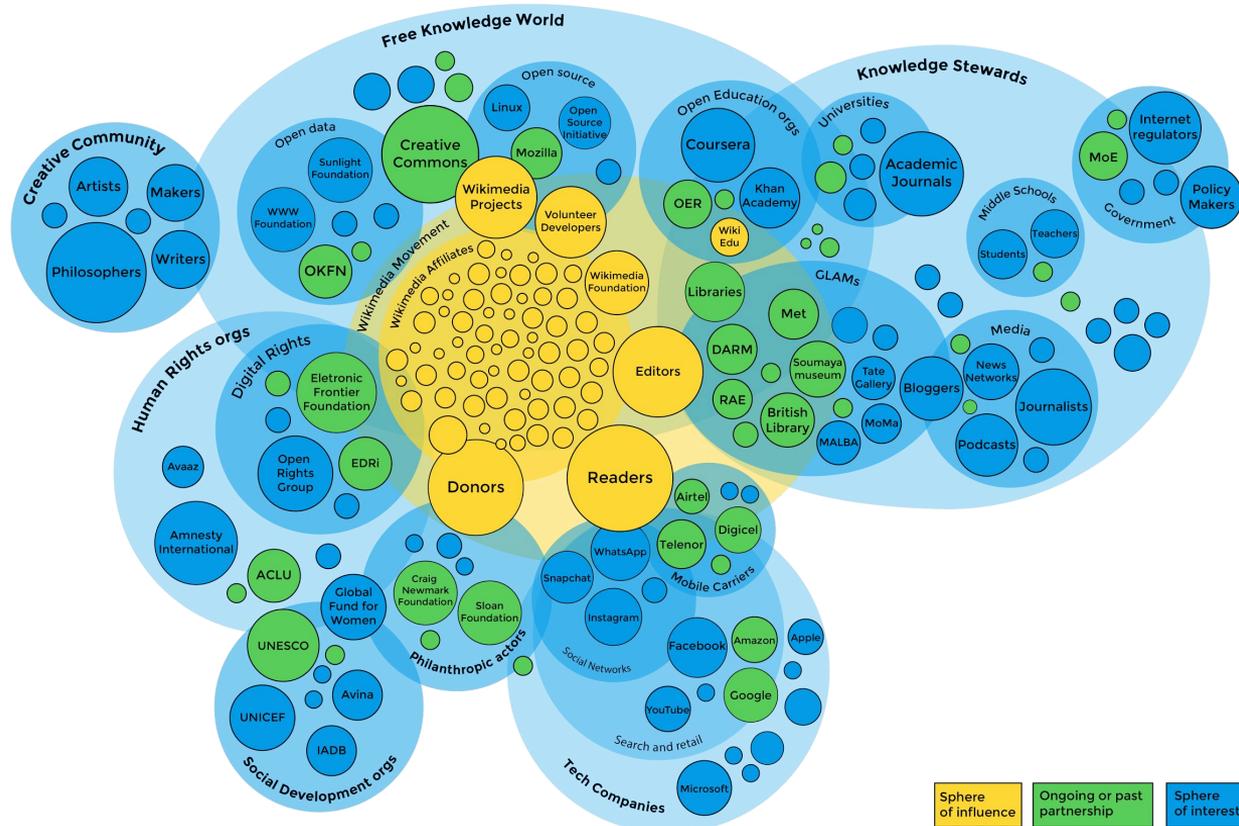
Getting Lost in the Museum
