# "WANTED" CLEAN SMOOTH COTTON

## For War Materials

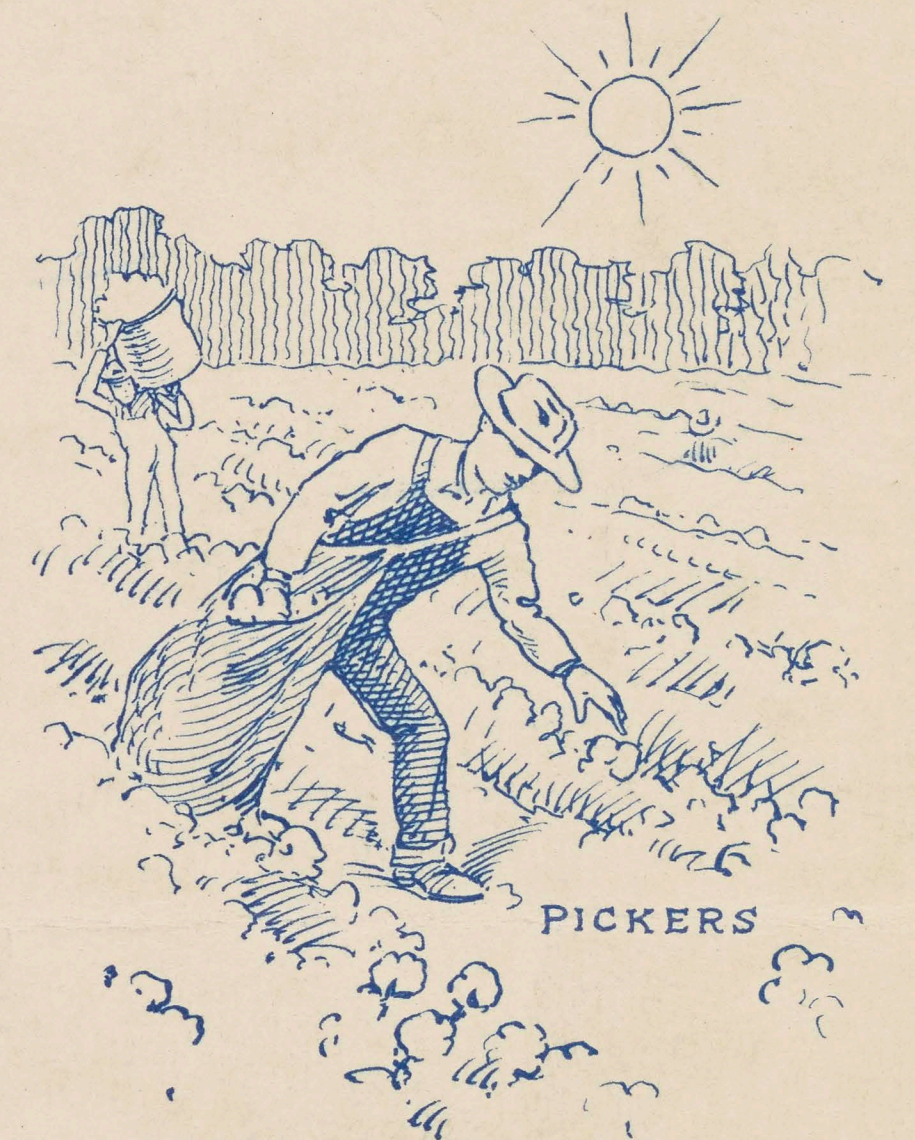


PARACHUTISTS' EQUIPMENT.



### COTTON PICKERS MUST:

- 1 PICK ONLY FULLY OPEN BOLLS. CRACKED BOLLS IS GREEN COTTON AND WILL CAUSE NEPPY FIBRE.
- 2 PICK COTTON CLEAN AND KEEP IT CLEAN. KEEP OUT LEAF PARTICLES AND BOLL TRASH.

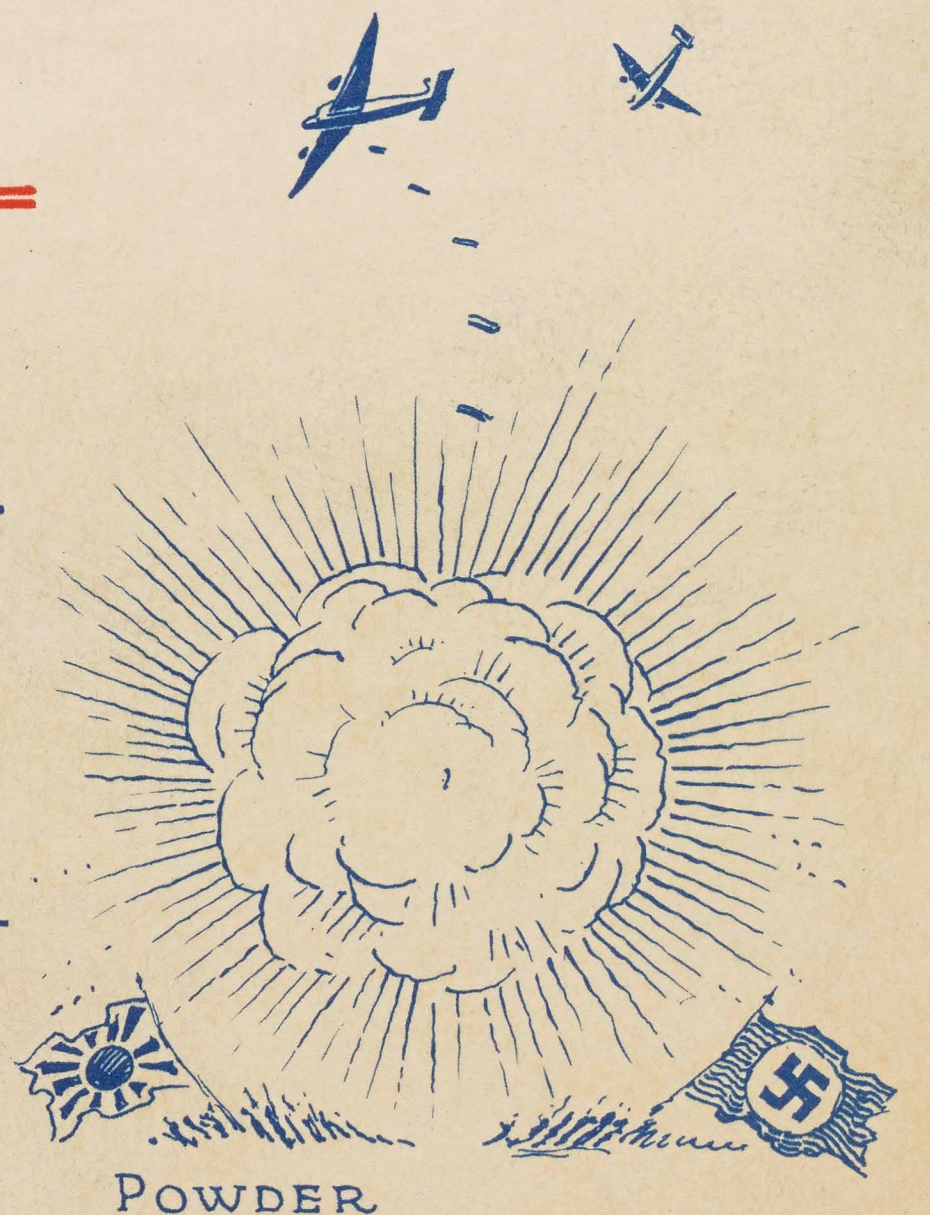

### COTTON GROWERS MUST:

- 1 HAVE COTTON PICKED AS PROMPTLY AS POSSIBLE.
- 2 HAVE COTTON PICKED WHEN IT IS DRY.
- 3 WHEN DAMP OR DEW-LADEN COTTON IS PICKED, SPREAD IT THIN IN THE SUN ON A SHEET OR TARPULIN. STORE UNDER SHELTER IN ABSENCE OF SUNSHINE. DO NOT TAKE DAMP COTTON TO THE GIN.
- 4 DO NOT PACK DAMP AND DRY LAYERS OF COTTON IN THE WAGON BOX. THIS TYPE OF "SANDWICH" IS IMPOSSIBLE TO GIN SMOOTH.
- 5 DO NOT LET IT RAIN ON COTTON AFTER IT IS PICKED.

### COTTON GINNERS MUST:

- 1 HAVE THEIR GIN IN PROPER ADJUSTMENT AND CONDITION.
- 2 ADJUST THE FEED AND KEEP A LOOSE SEED ROLL.
- 3 INSIST THAT COTTON BE DRY BEFORE GINNING.
- 4 AVOID PLATING BALES WHEN CHANGING CROPS OF DIFFERENT GRADE AND STAPLE.
