

Russia's war on Ukraine | Civil Protection Response since 6 May 2022

Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid response

Ukraine requested support from the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) in order to respond to the needs of the population affected by the war. As of 13 May, nearly **5.8 million** people have already fled Ukraine to EU while the internally displaced people are estimated to be over 8 million.

All EU Member States and 2 Participating States have offered items including shelter items (beds, tents, blankets, etc.), fire fighting equipment, personal protective equipment, vehicles, medicines, and other medical supplies. Three UCPM logistics hubs are operating in Poland, Romania and Slovakia, having already facilitated the delivery of about **30 000 tonnes** of assistance to Ukraine.

Poland, Slovakia, Czechia and Moldova have also activated the UCPM in order to manage the influx of people fleeing Russian military aggression. In addition, UNHCR has requested the assistance of UCPM for various shelter items.

The EU Provided **humanitarian assistance** to respond to the crisis for up to **EUR 243 million**, with EUR 230 million for Ukraine and 13 million EUR for Moldova. As of 13 May 12:00 CET

Total Assistance since 15 February 2022

- About **30 000 tonnes** assistance facilitated by the UCPM logistic hubs
- 29 countries** provided assistance (All 27 MS and 2 PS)
- 329 medical evacuations** to 11 countries (MEDEVAC)
- 10 EUCP teams, 46 UCPM experts and 10 Liaison officers deployed
