




#### Jane Evelyn Atwood Workshop

For one week in February 2005, Meredith College Photography 2 students, under the direction of Shannon Johnstone, had the unique opportunity to be in workshop with world renown photojournalist. Jane Evelyn Atwood.

Preparation for the shoot included slide lectures by Ms. Atwood which revealed how she got started in photography, what techniques she learned from her first assignments, and why she is drawn to document the people she chooses to photograph.

Students were exposed to an impressive, sometime distressing, but beautiful body of work which told the stories of French prostitutes, a man dying of AIDS, the world of the blind and finally, the personal devastation of land mines throughout the world.

During those short intense days, students were asked to document a subject in 48 hours, have proof prints developed, and return for an extensive critique.

Each student shot a minimum of 7 rolls of film. Subjects were as varied as the individuals who photographed them. We have a glimpse of a local barbershop, the life of a mail carrier and a diner employee, a peek into the performance world of the transvestite, the haunted atmosphere of an abandoned school, to mention a few.

We present, in this book, the work of these students.
