Prue had long yellow curls but not one single freckle.



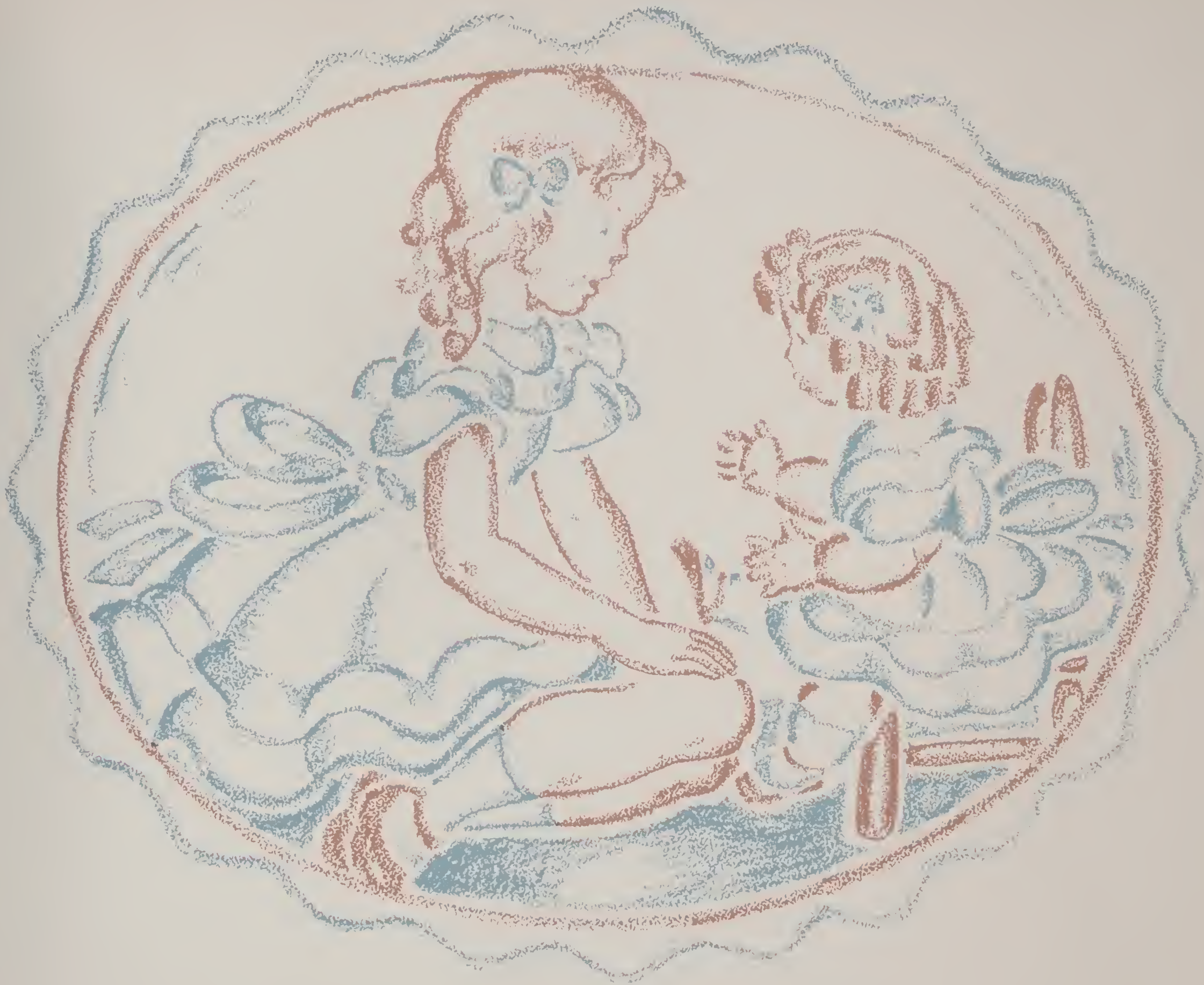
Polly had a ruffled dress with a blue ribbon. So did Prue. But Penny had no dress at all.

Piper looked at Penny. He did not say anything, but walked back and sat down in the tulip bed. He shook his head.

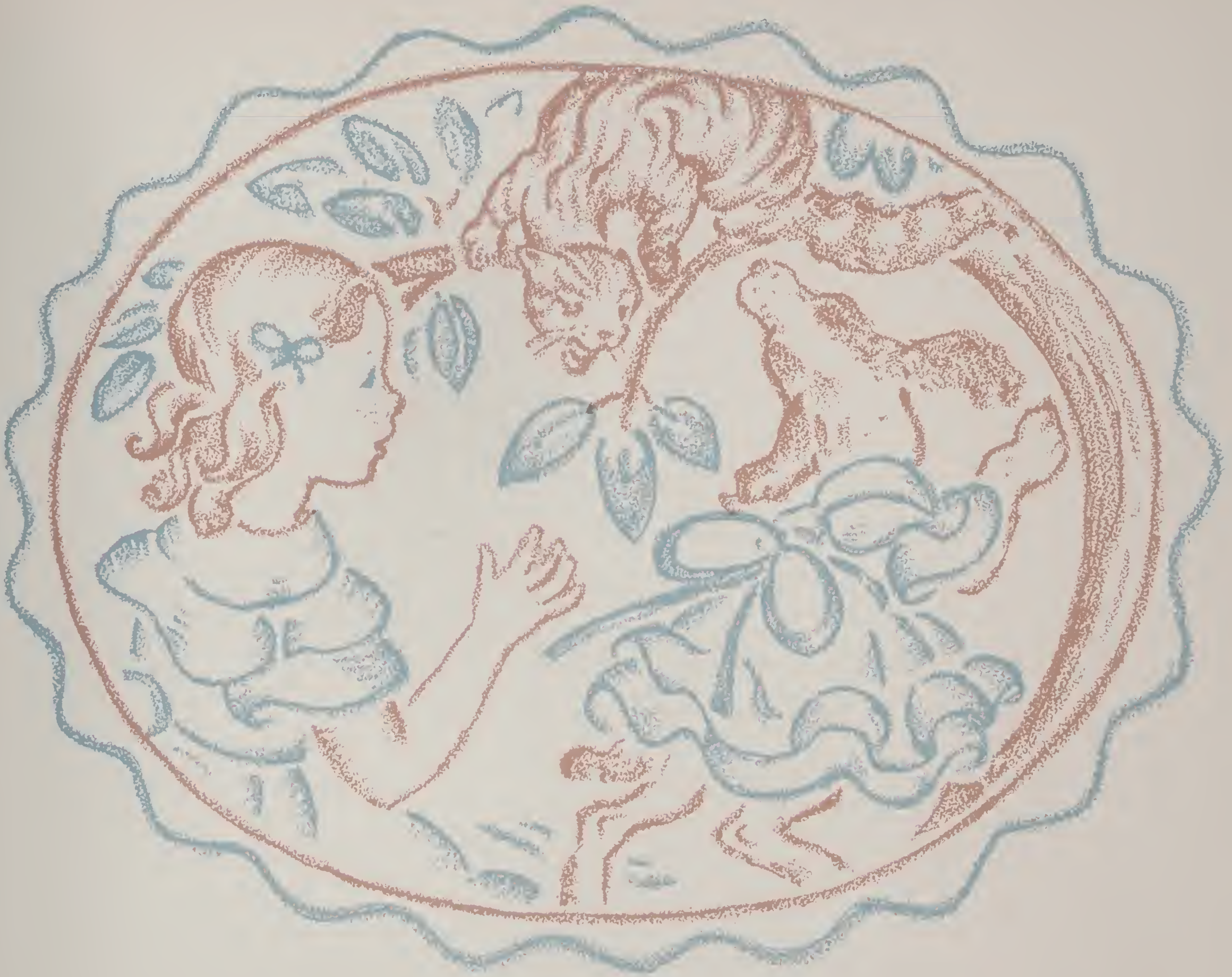


Penny was so ashamed. But Polly was proud of Penny in Prue's dress. She thought Penny looked very nice indeed. They went along the street quite fast.

“Oh, yes, let’s chase ducks!” said Ginger.

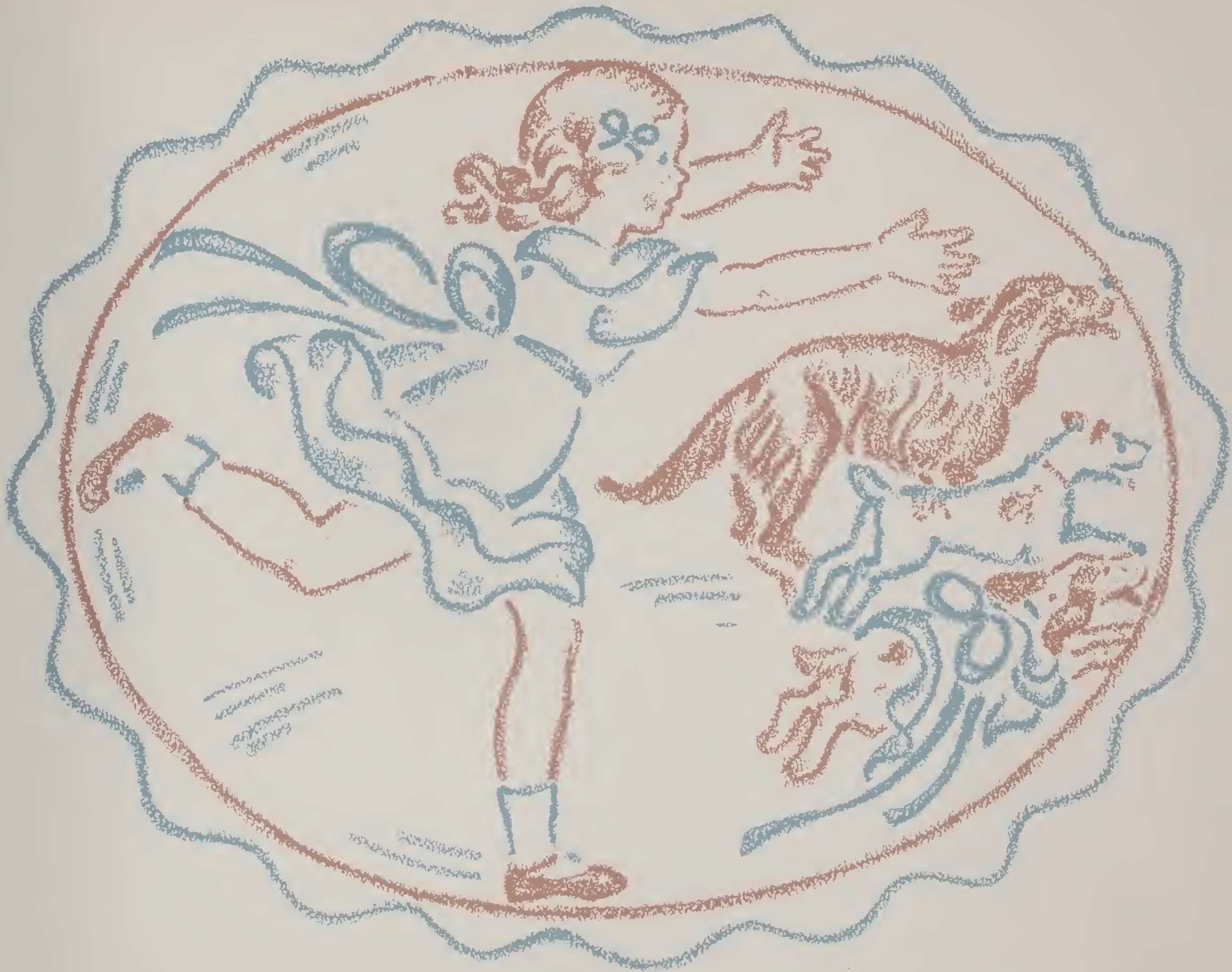
Penny said, “Bow wow!”



Ginger, Piper, and Penny ran down the street.



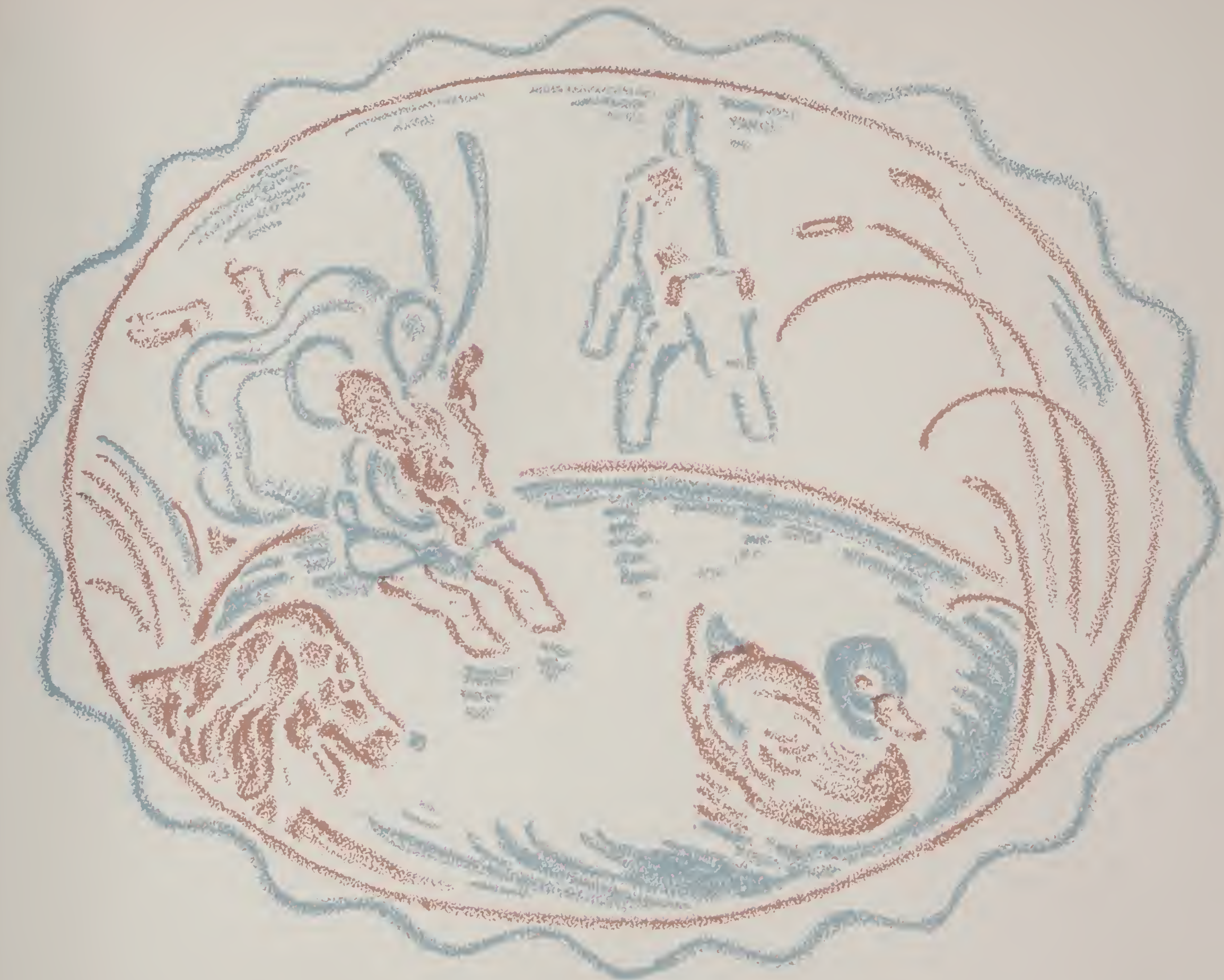
Polly ran after them, but she could not catch them.

Polly reached the edge of the pond.

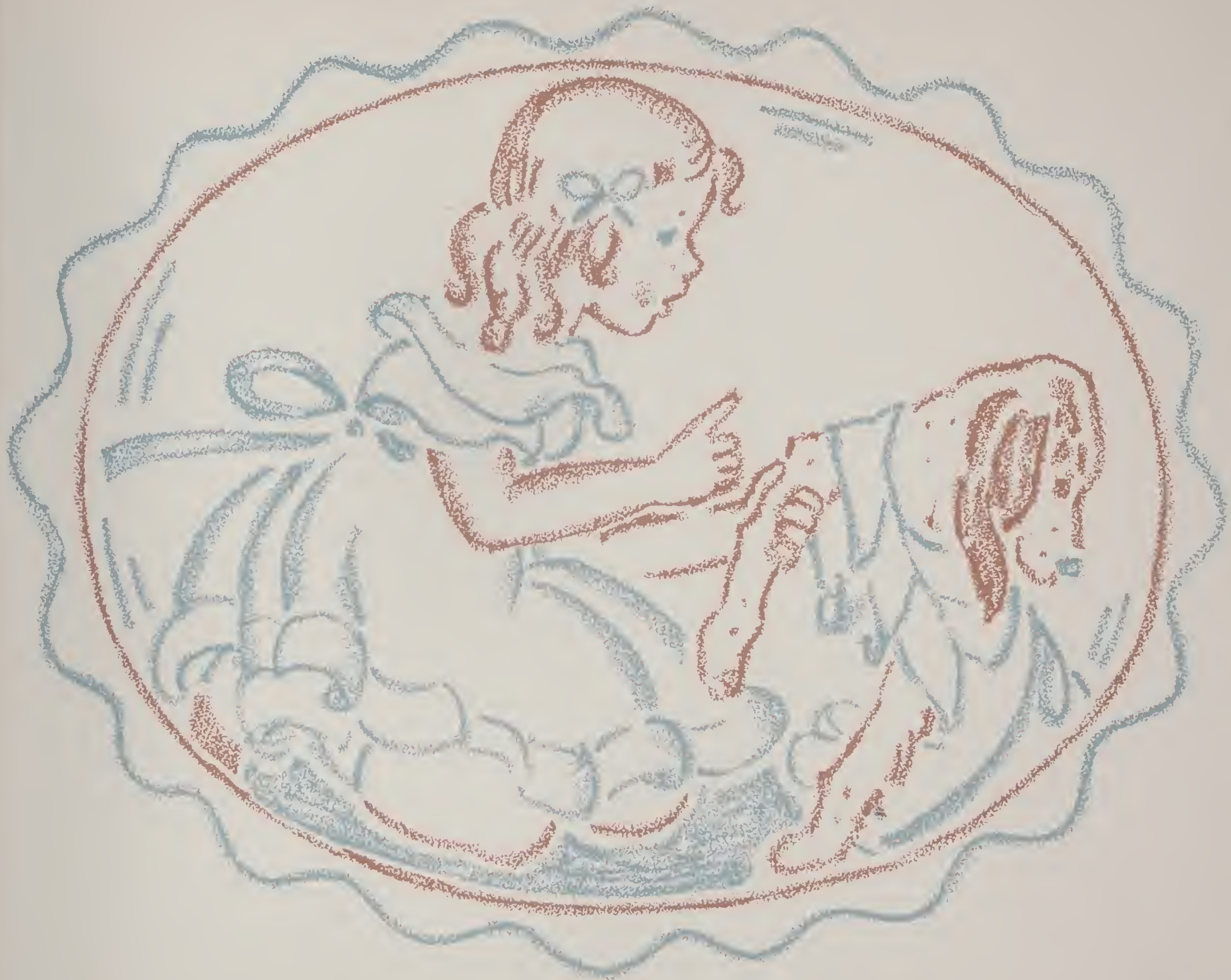
“Come here, you naughty dog!” she called.
