

CANNING MEAT AT HOME.

Meat can be canned at home and kept fresh any length of time, as follows: Slice up the raw meat and pack solid in glass cans, with fine salt enough to season, filling the cans full; then cook till tender by steaming; when done take out the cans and fill level full of hot water, then immediately fasten on the covers. If the pieces are not very thick, I prefer to cook them first, then remove all bones and gristle, filling the cans as before. If one is careful to have the cans full, and seal up boiling hot, the meat should keep. I have put up veal, pork and beef by the above methods, with uniformly good results. I now kill my "meat" at any season as wanted and can up what we can't use fresh, so I am independent of all butchers. I prefer the half-gallon cans, they being the cheapest and most convenient to use.—[E. C. B., Windham county, Vt.
