

As the result of the conference held by the village assemblymen of Hikami-mura regarding the proposed separation of Ishizuka Section and Kawahara Section of the village from Hikami-mura, they reached the resolution that an investigation committee composed of some of the village assemblymen should probe into the actual situation of the villages and the sections concerned.

The summary of the petition recently submitted to the village assembly of Hikami-mura by the representatives of the both section is as follows:

1. Ishizuka Section and Kawahara Section, being situated at the south-eastern corner of Hikami-mura are far distant from the central part of the village, while they are adjacent to the important centre of Tanaka-mura and such facilities of Tanaka-mura as the village office, the school, the agricultural cooperative association, the police box, the post office and the foodstuff distribution agency are all situated within quite small distances from the sections.
2. The farm lands cultivated by the farmers of Ishizuka Section and Kawahara Section mostly belong to Tanaka-mura and therefore there is a very close relation between the farmers of the sections and those of Tanaka-mura in their agricultural management as represented by irrigation facilities.
3. In order to insure a further development of the manufacturing and Commercial Entrepreneurs' Union which was organized jointly by the enterprizers of Tanaka-mura and those of the sections it is most convenient for them all to amalgamate the sections into Tanaka-mura, as most of the major shops and stores of Tanaka-mura stand face to face with the sections across a road.
4. It is far more convenient for the school children of the sections to go to the Tanaka-mura Primary School than to the Hikami-mura Primary School, as the former is far nearer than the latter from the sections.

According to the white paper on the financial conditions in Kochi-ken during Oct. last year to Mar. this year it was revealed that financial deficit of the prefectural treasury is becoming enormous owing to the fact that the Local Tax Law Revision Bill was shelved at the last session of the National Diet, while expenditures for public works, relief fund for medium and smaller enterprisers and unemployees are increasing. Therefore, the financial conditions of Kochi Prefectural Government are not in a ^{favorable} state, though increasing tendency of expenditures owing to disasters caused by the late earthquake and heavy rainfall has come almost to the normal state from last year.

The prefectural expenditures are classified as follows: --

Salaries --	¥ 1073,621 million	(30.9%)
Cost of supplies	¥ 925,238 "	(26.6%)
Subsidies --	¥ 769,792 "	(22.1%)
Consumptive expenditures	¥ 528,160 "	(15.2%)

However, to meet the above mentioned expenditures, 77% of the total revenue is from the national revenue and only 15% which corresponds to 527,564 million yen comes from prefectural sources, the fact of which shows the prefectural treasury depends to a great extent, to the national treasury.

The budget for the current fiscal year is made so as to cut expenditures, though the necessary expenditures for prevention of disaster, reconstruction works and stabilization of people's livelihood are appropriated to the utmost extent. The total amount of expenditures of general account is ¥ 2320364,600 which is classified into followings: --

Education --	31%
Public works	21%
Industry and economic affairs --	19%

As for revenue, the expected Local Tax Law will give a considerable change to the revenue of the prefecture, but the estimate of revenue made by the present system of taxation is as follows: --

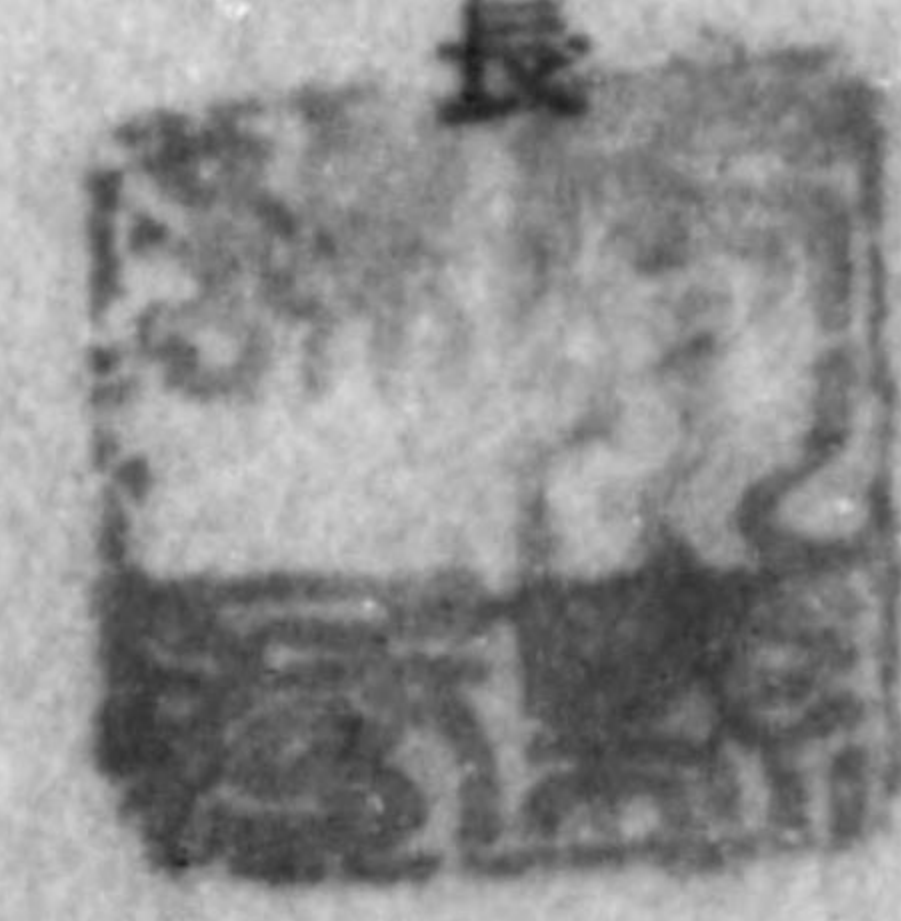


