sequence of training has been established; this sequence provides for the basic investigative training phase to be carried out at the CIC Center as a standardized course. Locally procured agents receive only that specialized training provided by the theater prior to assignment to CIC duties.

4. It is strongly suggested therefore that, prior to any future direct procurement of personnel within your command for CIC duty, coordination with the Chief, CIC, Camp Holabird, Maryland, be effected to ascertain the availability of trained, cleared personnel.

5. This suggested procedure in no way precludes local dismissal from CIC "for cause" by the theater commander in the event that an individual does not maintain high standards of efficiency and conduct; in fact, it is believed that current activity in thorough screening and subsequent dismissals, locally, should be intensified.
