Many spots must be affected. There must be exposed to friction & tension. . Nodule as ant. or seg. of mitral valve when it is connected to anterior chordae tendineae just where they pass from the heart. In 3. order the endocardium muscularis left aur. then right aur., left vent. & l. vent. (Evidently here means the chordae). The appendicularis more often affected than the auris.

Hoppe refers the greater part of Endo. in left heart to the stronger action of it.

Eidocard. differs from aortitis & endophytin in its more acute course & greater tendency to outgrowth - vegetations - explained by the greater liveness of the tissues & greater vascularity.

The vegetations. - The fibrinous deposits must be carefully distinguished - often very similar. At the transit & connection of the great endocardia with the vegetations - see p. 511. and pars.
