What is a Board?

A **board of directors** (commonly referred simply as **the board**) is an executive committee that jointly supervises the activities of an organization.

(Board of Directors, English Wikipedia)

In case of a nonprofit organisation, the **board of directors** is called **the board of trustees**







What do Boards do?

A Board's role is **oversight and strategy**.

A Board's oversight role includes **fiscal and legal responsibility**, as well as longer-term strategy.
