1. Reference 2nd Ind paragraph 2a; no buildings within half a mile, no street address, copies (trip) of military grid coordinates inclosed.
2. Paragraph 2, b; no new construction or rehabilitation required. (Except Target construction).
3. Paragraph 2, c; Care and Maintenance required; such as draining of two (2) feet of water out of target pit, repairing of pit to stop leakage and cutting of brush ar firing point. Also construction of targets.
4. Paragraph 2 d, attached copies of plot plan show area. Targets are backed by a high cliff; on one side is a mountain, on the other side a twenty-five (25) feet dyke. One entrance is from behind the firing line.
5. Paragraph 2, e; land between firing point and target was under cultivation the past year. Land is not school property, but privately owned; (see basic communication). Land owner is undecided as to whether or not he wants to use land this year. He has been informed that he could cultivate and plant the land if he wishes as it would not interfere with our use of the range for approximately 36 hours a month. The range of fire would be several feet above any crop growth.
