Wikivoyage – Quick Facts



- Wikivoyage is a free web-based travel guide for travel destinations and travel topics written by volunteer authors
- It is a sister project of Wikipedia and supported and hosted by the same non-profit Wikimedia- Foundation (WMF)
 - Wikivoyage has been called the "Wikipedia of travel guides"
 - Wikivoyage initially started as Wikitravel in 2003

Wikitravel – Quick Facts



- •Wikitravel is a web-based collaborative travel guide based on the wiki model and owned by Internet Brands
- •It was most active from 2003 through 2012, when most of its editing community left and brought their contributions to the nonprofit Wikivoyage guide
- Wikivoyage came into existence with the German and Italian version on 10 Dec. 2006
 - The English Wikivoyage started on 15 Jan. 2013
 - •Among the Indic languages Wikivoyage exists in Bengali and Hindi

- Part of Wikimedia Foundation
 - Shows no advertisement

Wikipedia vs Wikivoyage



Wikipedia

- Citation required
- Can be on any encyclopedic topic
 - Broader coverage beyond travel
 - No banner

Wikivoyage

- No citation required
- Only on travel topics
- Coverage only on travel
 - Banner
