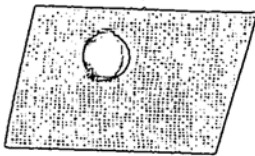

Reference is made to my letter dated May 9, 1960,  
in captioned matter.

During an interview on April 28, 1960, Mujal made available eight items, written in the Spanish language, containing data concerning persons allegedly residing in Cuba. He specifically requested that the data contained in these items be furnished to you. It has been determined through a cursory review that the material pertains to persons living in Cuba who are reportedly associated with the communist movement in that country. Since the data appears to be of primary interest to your Agency, these items are being forwarded to you. In connection with the items, Mujal has indicated that he does not desire they be returned to him. (C)(u)

Enclosed are the following described items:

(1) Three six inch by eight inch books, two of which are cardboard covered, separated with alphabetical dividers and marked "A L" and "M Z". The third book is bound with an Acco fastener and is divided by five labeled tabs. With regard to these items, Mujal claimed that the persons and organizations mentioned therein are connected with the communist movement and that the information set forth was gathered in Cuba since the rise of Fidel Castro. (2) A list of names on a single sheet of paper, bearing the letterhead "Ministerio Del Trabajo, of some of which are marked by red pencil. According to Mujal, the (C)(u)

names checked are individuals publicly known in Cuba as communists. Staped to this sheet of paper is a list of names captioned "Comunistas En Los Laboratorios Timouti Fouzet." (S)(U)

(3) One eleven-page document captioned "Federacion Gastronomica" that contains biographical data concerning various individuals listed therein. (S)(U)

(4) One three-and-one-half-page document captioned "Federacion Tabacalera Nacional" which lists the officers of that union and furnishes background data on those who are alleged to be communists. According to Mujal, those known to be communists are listed in red in this item. (S)(U)

(5) A group of miscellaneous papers bound with string which contains data and newspaper clippings concerning the various individuals listed among the papers. One page of this group is captioned "Relacion De Los Presidentes O Encargados De Los Comites Nacionales Del Concurso Pro-Festival De La Juventud Y Sus Direcciones Postales." Mujal advised that this page was stolen from the headquarters of the Communist Party located on Carlos Tercero Street, Havana, Cuba. (S)(U)

(6) One manila folder entitled "Propagandas Y Volantes Del P.S.P." which contains various examples of propaganda presently being issued in Cuba. (S)(U)

It is requested that you advise this Bureau of any information of interest noted in the enclosed items.
