Title is the debut **extended play** (EP) by American singer-songwriter **Meghan Trainor** (*pictured*). Trainor wrote all of its songs with its producer, **Kevin Kadish**. The two conceived the EP shortly after Trainor signed with **Epic Records** in 2014. The label released it on September 9, 2014. Inspired by **doo-wop** from the **1950s**, *Title* comprises songs that lie between **modern R&B** and melodic **pop**. The EP has a lyrical theme of commitment and staying true to oneself, which Trainor hoped would **empower women**. It includes Trainor's debut **single**, "**All About That Bass**", which reached number one in 58 countries with worldwide sales of 11 million units. *Title* garnered mixed reviews from critics, who thought its

What is a scholarship? [edit]

It is a financial support given to an individual to cover the costs associated with attending a conference. The purpose of women camp scholarships is to create equal opportunities for women to participate in camp activities and benefit from the unique experiences, learning, and personal development opportunities that camp can provide.

Categories [edit]

With an intention to ensure effective implementation and maximize program impact, the program of the Women camp is split into two cohorts- Strategy and Capacity Building.

The two themes, strategy and capacity building, will allow for a focused and comprehensive approach. The strategy theme will emphasize on vision, planning, and stakeholder engagement, while the capacity building theme will focus on enhancing skills, resources, and sustainability.

The scholarship seats are also split into two sections, following the same approach where **25 seats are reserved for strategy** while **35 for capacity building cohort**.

Overall, 45 seats are reserved for international and 15 are reserved for regional participants.

In September, you may upload as many pictures as you want of monuments that you have visited. Pictures don't have to be taken in September, but must be uploaded during that month to be considered. At the end of the month, the contest jury will begin evaluating the photographs and will choose the best 10 pictures of the monuments in Croatia, and ultimately in the world.

5. Pictures must be encyclopedic and prominently feature one of the more than 26,000 nationally recognized monuments.

general explanation

Banner campaigns: banner design

- text: what do you want from the reader when they click?
- image: simple and clear
- Banner in multiple languages?
Translate the landing page also!

After the campaign goes live:

- expect engagement coming in through your landing page. Email, but also the talkpage.

What does a CN admin need to create my banner?

- 1 or 2 lines of text, max 50-70 characters
- one image, not too much details! Because displayed at 55-65px.
- The link to you landing page

Difference banner/campaign

- campaign = technical backend (countries, languages, projects)
- banner = the visual presentation

Creating your own banner

Possible, but be aware!

- Test on different devices, browsers and operating systems
- Not in wikicode: HTML, CSS and Javascript combination
- Not in an image!! (does not scale on mobile devices and tables)

That said, CN admins are happy to work with your code (if kindly asked in time), create the banner (without it going live) and share a preview link with you so you can work on and test your code in multiple ways.

Alternatives

- Sitenotice!! local admin access
- Geonotice or Watchlist Summary
- Massmessage (opt-in Mediawiki feature)
- **NEW** meta:Events: namespace for event registration - now live on Meta, but namespaces can be activated per request on every wiki (affiliate wiki's, language wiki's etc)
