1. Surveillance as requested in the basic communication was conducted by the Civil Property Custodian Section attached to this team.

2. A total of 7,827,449 kilograms of chinese copper and nickel coins were restored to China in three different shipments. On 8 September 1948 1,867,050 kilograms of copper coins were shipped on the SS Hai Liao, on 30 September 1948 3,997,200 kilograms of copper and nickel coins were shipped on the SS Hai Hsung, and on 13 October 1948 1,963,099 kilograms of copper and nickel coins were shipped on SS Hai Liao.

2. It is desired that Eighth Army exercise surveillance and render assistance as necessary to insure Japanese compliance with instructions for packaging, transfer and delivery of subject property to the ports as designated in reference memorandum.
