July, 1906	Entered the law course of the law college of the TOKYO Imperial University. (Concurrently studied German law) Graduated in 1912.
December 21, 1907	Awarded the 5th Court Rank, Junior Grade.
February 10, 1912	Succeeded to the Peerage. (Baron)
November 9, 1914	Employed in the War Ministry and received treatment as a junior official and attached to the 18th Independent Divisional Headquarters.
November 28, 1914	Attached to the TSINGTAO Garrison Headquarters.
January 21, 1916	Awarded the 5th Court Rank, Senior Grade.
March 20, 1916	Appointed as probational procurator by the War Ministry, Appointed member of the Military Courts Martial by the War Ministry. Granted a salary of 500 yen per annum by the War Ministry. Attached to the Judicial Department of the 1st Division by the War Ministry.
December 4, 1917	Appointed as a procurator. Awarded with the 7th Grade, Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet. Granted salary class, 10th grade by the War Ministry. Appointed member of the Judicial Department of the 17th Division by the War Ministry.
June 30, 1919	Granted salary class, 9th grade by the War Ministry.
July 1, 1920	Granted salary class, 8th grade by the War Ministry.
September 17, 1920	Relieved from his main post and appointed as member of the Judicial Department of the 11th Division by the War Ministry.
August 18, 1920	The amendment to the Higher Civil Service Salary Regulations applied from August.
December 28, 1920	Granted salary class, 9th grade by the War Ministry

June 25, 1921	Promoted to the 6th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet.
November 1, 1920	Conferred with the Imperial Order of the Sacred Treasure, 6th Class and a grant of 400 yen for services in the 1915-1920 war.

December 26, 1921	Granted Salary class, 7th grade by the Education Ministry.
April 1, 1922	According to Article No. 540 of the Appendix in the Ordinance No. 85 enacted in 1921, the procurator shall become the Army Judge Advocate. Appointed Judge Advocate of the Military Courts Martial of the 16th Division by the War Ministry.
January 30, 1923	Awarded with the 4th Court Rank, Junior Grade.
December 28, 1923	Granted salary class, 6th grade by the War Ministry.
June 30, 1924	Promoted to the 5th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet.
November 28, 1924	Decorated with the Imperial Orders of the Sacred Treasure, 5th Class.
June 20, 1927	Promoted to the 4th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet. Granted salary class, 5th Grade by the War Ministry.
September 6, 1928	Appointed Judge Advocate of the Military Courts Martial of the 11th Division by the War Ministry.
March 31, 1930	Appointed Judge Advocate of the Military Courts Martial of the 14th Division by the War Ministry.
June 20, 1930	Granted salary class, 4th grade by the War Ministry.
February 16, 1931	Awarded with the 4th Court Rank, Senior Grade.
November 7, 1931	Decorated with the Imperial Order of the Sacred Treasure, 4th Class.
June 9, 1932	Concurrently appointed as an Army Judicial Official. Promoted to the 4th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet. Appointed chief of the Judicial Affairs Department of the 14th Division by the War Ministry. Concurrently appointed as the Judge Advocate of the Military Courts Martial of the KWANTUNG Army by the War Ministry.

May 24, 1934 Concurrently appointed chief of military prisons.
Promoted to the 5th Grade, Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet.
Appointed head of the UTSUNOMIYA Military Prison by the War
Ministry.

recorded in the official gazette.

September 7, 1937 Relieved from his concurrent position as chief of military prisons
by the Cabinet.

October 31, 1937 Granted salary class, 2nd grade by the War Ministry.

June 24, 1938 Relieved from his concurrent position by the Cabinet.
Relieved from his main post by the War Ministry. Not recorded
in the official gazette.

October 2, 1939 Concurrently appointed as Army Judge Advocate.
Appointed to 3rd Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the
Cabinet.

October 2, 1939 Concurrently appointed as chief of military prisons.
Appointed to the 5th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the
Cabinet.

October 2, 1939 Appointed as Judge Advocate of the Military Courts Martial
of the 2nd Division by the War Ministry.

October 2, 1939 Appointed chief of the Judicial Affairs Department of the 2nd
Home Division by the War Ministry.

October 2, 1939 Appointed as head of the SENDAI Military Prison by the War Ministry. Not recorded in the official gazette.

January 15, 1940 Awarded with the 3rd Court Rank, Junior Grade.

October 31, 1940 Granted salary class, 1st grade by the War Ministry.

December 2, 1940 Relieved from his main post as chief of military prisons by the cabinet.

April 10, 1941 Concurrently appointed as chief of military prisons. Awarded with the 5th Grade of the Higher Civil Service by the Cabinet.

March 31, 1942 Relieved from his concurrent position by the Cabinet.

April 1, 1942 Appointed as Colonel in the Judicial Branch of the Army by the Cabinet.

April 1, 1942 According to Imperial Ordinance No. 325 of 1942, the Army Judge Advocacy was abolished.
