MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF, G-1.
(Attention Brig. General R. W. Berry)

Subject: Personnel for Secretariat of the State-War-Navy
Coordinating Committee

Reference memorandum addressed to your office by the
Assistant Secretary of War, dated 20 December 1944. It is
requested that a temporary authorization be granted for
personnel as listed below:

- 1 Administrative Assistant (Major or lower grade)
- 2 Administrative Assistants (WAC officers)
- 4 Stenographers (Grades to be determined)
- 3 File Clerks (Grades to be determined)
- 1 Draftsman (Grade to be determined)
- 1 Telephone operator (Grade to be determined)
- 2 Messengers (Grades to be determined)

All the above listed, except the administrative assistants,
to be enlisted personnel either WAC or limited service males.

During the period of establishment it is difficult to
determine just what the ultimate requirements for personnel may
be. Under this proposed temporary authorization, the organization
may be from time to time either increased or, should the volume
of work so indicate, decreased. At such time as the duties and
functions of the committee become firm and well established, a
formal Table of Organization will be submitted for approval.
