



Article 1. The Opening of the Special Railroad- Control Office and the Station Commands.

After the occurrence of the incident on Sept.

18, 1931, an Incidental office was arranged in

the Railroad Department of the S.M.R.C., where some

military officers in attaché to the C. and some

clerks were assigned with the function of planning

and performances of concentrated army transport.

The main office first composed at TAIHEN and transferred next day to Mukden; The railroad offices at Mukden and Changchun have also arranged to open incidental offices.

On the Sept. 21. The Army Order for the arrangement of the Special Railroad-Section Control Office was issued and started to work.

"KWAN-KO - Order. No. 3."

"The Special Railroad-Sections Control Office, branch office and station commands are to be composed to comply with the affixed planning sheets.
