Quarantine Installations and Procedures

- 1. Reference is made to memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 567 (1 Oct 47)PH, subject as above (SCAPIN 1787).
- 2. In addition to the ports of entry listed in reference, the ports of Kagoshima and Hakata are designated as ports of entry but for Japanese shipping only.
- 3. The Japanese Government will provide quarantine services at these ports of entry, as required by the Commanding General, Eighth Army, for handling Japanese shipping.
