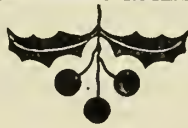

For Your Information



To those who are not acquainted with our concern, would say that this business was established in 1870 and is still under the same management.

We are located in Southwestern Iowa, fifty miles southeast of Omaha, Nebraska. The soil here is especially adapted to the growing of a general line of nursery stock. The railroad facilities are excellent. We are on the Wabash, Chicago, Burlington and Quincy, Keokuk and Western railroads; two express companies, the Adams and Wells-Fargo, give us good service. We take pleasure in showing visitors over our grounds at any time.

TERMS OF SALE

SHIPPING—The shipping season in the Fall begins about October 1st. Parties ordering goods should indicate whether they wish them sent by freight, express or parcel post, also route. In the absence of these instructions, we forward them to the best of our judgement, but in no case will we assume responsibility after consignment to purchaser. When losses occur by delays or other causes of whatever nature while goods are in transit, make claim AT ONCE on the forwarding companies.

TERMS—Cash or security before shipment of goods, except with established firms when, if unknown to us, satisfactory references will be required before goods are forwarded. Orders to be sent C. O. D. should be accompanied by one-fourth cash.

PRICES—Are limited to Fall, 1915, and supersede all previous lists and are subject to change without notice.

CAUTION—We accept all orders on condition that they shall be void should any injury befall stock from frost, fire, hail, storms or other causes over which we have no control.

CLAIMS—For deduction will receive consideration only when made within six days after receipt of goods.

PACKING—Prices contained herein are net; cost of boxing and baling will be added.

GRADES We grade carefully; in some cases by caliper, in others by height. When graded by both caliper and height, the caliper must govern.

CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION—Will be furnished with each shipment.

OUR GUARANTEE OF GENUINENESS—While we exercise proper diligence to have our trees, etc., true to label and hold ourselves in readiness, on proper proof, to replace all trees, etc., that may prove untrue to label, free of charge, or refund the amount paid, it is mutually understood and agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that our guarantee of genuineness shall in no case make us liable for any sum greater than originally received for said trees, etc. that prove untrue.

French Grown

We are not agents for French nurserymen but we have our own representative in France who has our seedlings grown for us on contract by men who make a specialty of growing fruit tree stocks.

We have a storage building where the seedlings are inspected, graded and packed. They are then shipped in car load lots to us at Shenandoah where we open every box and carefully inspect the grading and condition of the stock. A government inspector is also stationed at Shenandoah the entire winter and he inspects these seedlings.

We wish to impress on our customers the importance of sending in their orders early, before any items are sold out.

We wish to call attention to the fact that these goods are sold NET AT SHENANDOAH, IOWA.

We take all risks of transportation from France to this place. This is a very important point for customers to remember. Sometimes there is quite a loss in these long shipments, but when sold net at Shenandoah this does not affect the customers as we open up the boxes and grade out the damaged seedlings and guarantee our stock to be in good condition when it is delivered to the forwarding agent at Shenandoah.

All goods sold subject to arrival, without engagement, and subject to war conditions.
