
• How and through what have you gained awareness for certain topics in your life? (eg. travel, books, special encounters, stroke of fate)





Key Findings conducted by community events

- Problems analysed in workshops with different community groups:
 - Destructive communication & conflict resolution (bodies)
 - Dealing with newbies
 - Too many rules, dodgy rule application
 - Rejection of gender-sensitive language



Destructive behaviour from the perspective of the people affected

Destructive communication

- Unconstructive criticism in early stages of volunteer work (deletion of articles rather than support for improvement) Frequently: <u>Wiki-Hounding</u>, stalking, sexist
- insults
- Rarely: doxing, hate mail, death threats

Trigger

- Informal hierarchies create power structures
- Admins decisions
- Confusing set of rules Source citation vs. access to scientific databases



Analysis of causes of conflicts

- Conflict resolution bodies
- Set of rules
 - Too many
 - Too complex
- Technical requirements don't support a constructive conflict solution
- Self-conception of what Wikipedia is



Research findings and raising awareness

- Raising awareness = irritation, admission of wrongdoing, willingness to unlearn
- Transfer of findings
 - Timing
 - Personal relation to the problem
 - Participation to support community engagement
- Appreciation of community's expert opinion
