## Activities History [\[ edit \]](#)

**September 2007**, the idea of a Wikimedia Asia project was first coined and discussed by Anirudh Bhati, Cary Bass, THD and Jeremy Chan.

**November 2009**, Wikimedia Hong Kong started the discussion of Wikimedia Asia Project through e-mail. After the discussion between most of the Asian chapters, they decided to apply a mailing list to Wikimedia Foundation for Asian Chapters.

**December 2009**, Wikimedia Foundation approved the mailing list application of Asian chapters.

**February 2010**, the first draft of Wikimedia Asia Project was published.

**April 2010**, the first Asian Chapters Meet Up was held in the Chapter Meeting 2010 in Berlin, Germany.

**July 2010**, the panel of Wikimedia Asia and the second Asian Chapters Meet Up were held in Wikimania 2010, Gdańsk, Poland.

**August 2011**, an informal Asian Wikimedians' lunch was held in Wikimania 2011, Haifa, Israel.

# After 2012: Asia Meetup

Asia Wikimedia Meetup became a regular occurrence during Wikimania 2013 in Hong Kong and in the Wikimanias it succeeded, Wikimedia Conferences in Berlin and Milan and the Wikimedia Summit.



# 2014 - 2015: ESEA

During the sidelines of Wikimania 2014 in London and in the Wikimedia Conference 2015 in Berlin, participants from East and South East Asia gathered and talked about the purpose to collaborate “in a regional way”.



# 2016-2017 : ESEA to ESEAP

This paved for the plan of a regional conference called “*ESEA Meeting*”. Australia was part of the discussions, and during the Wikimedia Conference 2017 Pacific region was admitted to the group and ESEAP was formed.

# ESEAP to host Wikimania 2020

The Wikimania Steering Committee in March 2019 offered hosting of Wikimania 2020 to ESEAP and the host location will be in Bangkok, Thailand. Plans for having the ESEAP Conference were shelved and planned to integrate to Wikimania.





# Oops... COVID-19 happend

The ESEAP Wikimania Core Organizing Team made a tough decision to postpone Wikimania till 2021 and eventually cancel it.

On August 2020, ESEAP decided to hold virtual meetings. Every month since, ESEAP had been gathering virtually.

## Wikimania is postponed until 2021.

A letter from Katherine Maher to the Wikimedia Community  
18 March 2020

Dear everyone,

As a part of the Wikimedia movement's ongoing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are postponing Wikimania Bangkok 2020. This decision was made with the full support of the ESEAP host team and Wikimania Committee. Together, we will hold Wikimania in Bangkok in 2021.

We are filled with sadness to not see you all in Bangkok in August. However, we are confident that this is the best possible decision for the well-being of our global community and public health overall. This decision was proposed by the ESEAP organizers in line with their countries' response to the COVID-19 pandemic and is in line with recommendations from the World Health Organization (WHO).

You are certain to have many questions. We hope to answer some of your questions below. We will continue to answer questions on the Wikimania Meta-Wiki page and on the Wikimania Telegram group chat (more information below).

### What does "postponing" Wikimania mean?

We will not host an in-person Wikimania in 2020. We are rescheduling Wikimania Bangkok until 2021. The ESEAP organizing team will continue their work as a regional collaborative between affiliates in the East, South East, and Pacific regions to host us in Thailand next year.

The hotel and venue in Bangkok will remain the same. We have not yet finalized dates for 2021. We will work with the ESEAP team and Wikimania Steering Committee to confirm new dates. We will let you know these dates by the end of 2020.

(English / 英語) ESEAP accepted the invitation to host the in-person **Wikimania** in 2023 following the cancellation of 2020 Wikimania in Bangkok due to COVID. ESEAP has been working with the WMF and the Steering Committee to assess the risks of countries within our region. The 23rd ESEAP community meeting was held using Google meet on 12 July 2022, those who attended this meeting chose to narrow down the options to two countries, namely **Singapore** and **Japan**. We invite everyone in the ESEAP community to decide which country they would prefer Wikimania 2023 to be in, while the second choice will be the alternative option should there be the need. We ask that you vote for your preferred option below.

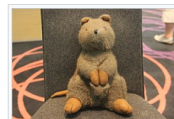
