History of the sample

The sample, male\_thijs\_loud\_scream was recorded back in the days Than van Nispen t.P. studied biology in Utrecht, The Netherlands, and in his free time participated in projects where sound-fx or film-music were needed.

The sample was recorded late 2001 in his student-apartment for some special effects for an interactive theatre play in which Than helped with sound-fx and foley for short animations...

This time a lot of screams were needed as special effect sounds for some fake 'torturing' device within the play.


Thijs, a friend of Than's, showed the person who was doing some voice over screaming sessions, 'how to do it'.

So... that's why there's currently only 'one' Thijs-sample in my collection...

Apparently it turned out to be sort of an unique and 'lucky' shot!

The sample was recorded at 44.1 KHz with a Shure SM58 microphone and with a Terratec EWS 88 MT sound-card.

When Than learned to know the freesound project he thought that maybe other people could also use this sample and other scream-samples in their work or projects and so finally it ended up in the movie 'Children of Men'...



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





#### About the Liberated Pixel Cup

Liberated Pixel Cup is a two-part competition: make a bunch of awesome free culture licensed artwork, and then program a bunch of free software games that use it.

Liberated Pixel Cup brings together some powerful allies: Creative Commons, Mozilla, OpenGameArt, the Free Software Foundation, and you.

#### The artwork
