been divided into Eight Lots exclusive of so much of it  
as is retained for the Brick Man in the rear. The dimen-  
sions of each is specified by figures on the dividing  
lines this Plan also shows a Court or Street should the  
same be carried out would occupy so much of the Lot as  
is marked the rear in figures in possession of the Curum  
and would enter George Street as the Plot shown opposite  
College Street - September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1840 by Robert Quash Pinckney
