SUBJECT: Application for Release of Evaluated Properties
from Custody Designation

With regard to release from custody designation of evaluated properties an application to the following effect being submitted to this department by the Takaoka factory of the Nippon Stainless K.K., your special consideration into these peculiar points is requested to grant their application.

- (1) The Takaoka factory of the Nippon Stainless K.K. renounced its operation because of poor management in March 1949, but has been paying a careful attention for the full custody of reparations.
- (2) For the purpose of erecting Takaoka Citizen's Hospital, recently the site on which any designated installations do not stand, and all of the establishments not containing them have been arranged to be transferred to Takaoka city authorities. Therefore, the company hereby makes an application in order that a concurrent transfer of the evaluated properties irrelevant to custody of the designated properties, such as business utensils, worker's welfare facilities, constructions and wired electric wires, may be made to the same authorities.
- (3) The objects signified by the application are business utensils, worker's welfare facilities, constructions, and the wired electric wires existing within such establishments as have already been exempted and are in course of application for exemption from reparations.

Remarks:

The abovestated electric wires belong to each unit shop and have been counted in the evaluation inventory as one of the miscellaneous equipments, bearing separate evaluation number.

Business utensils, worker's welfare facilities and other constructions, being stated only in the summary schedule, and being not described in the evaluation inventory, have borne no separate evaluation number.

Our Takaoka plant was designated for reparational custody on Oct. 10, 1946, after which time we were concentrating out utmost efforts on the custody, maintenance and guard of reparations-designated machines, besides continuing some of our production activities.

But, the depression of business obliged to stop our above production activities temporarily on Oct. 4, 1948 and since Mar. 1949 when the Takaoka plant was closed all of the reparations-designated machines and buildings have not been made available for production activities and other effective ways at all.

Recently, full understanding has also been realized between the interesting parties as to the utilization of some acreage of the plant as the site of the Takaoka Citizens' Hospital, Health Insurance system in embryo which has long been expected by all of the Takaoka city people.

In this connection, we should like to remove further the reparations-designated machines within some of the buildings which are not still excluded from the reparational custody, and this is the reason why we have submitted an application as enclosed herewith for the removal of the former land and buildings.

We shall be appreciated very much if the authorities concerned will kindly permit the removal with their esteemed and favorable understandings.

With regard to the above subject, we received an application as listed hereunder from the Takaka Plant of Nippon Stainless Steel Co., Ltd., at No.860 Mukaino-machi, Takaka-shi, Toyama-ken.

You are requested to render special consideration from the realization of it.

1. The land and buildings listed in the application is to use as a filling place of the natural gas to be delivered from Kejiro in Himi-gun after the said properties are sold to Toyama Natural Gas Co., Ltd. The quantity of the gas is about 5,000 cubic meters per day, in other words, 1,300 gallons of gasoline can be saved when it is used as car fuel.
2. The said building occupies one of the most important traffic ways, so it is the most good place for storing of the natural gas.
3. No reparations equipment is contained in the building.
4. In the event that the applied properties are exempted from reparations designation, there will remain less guard responsibility and more strengthened surveillance.
5. There will be no interference occurred in the continuance of the maintenance responsibility, though the guard center is included in the would-be-exempted area. The guard center box will be moved to the east guard box to resume the guard duty.

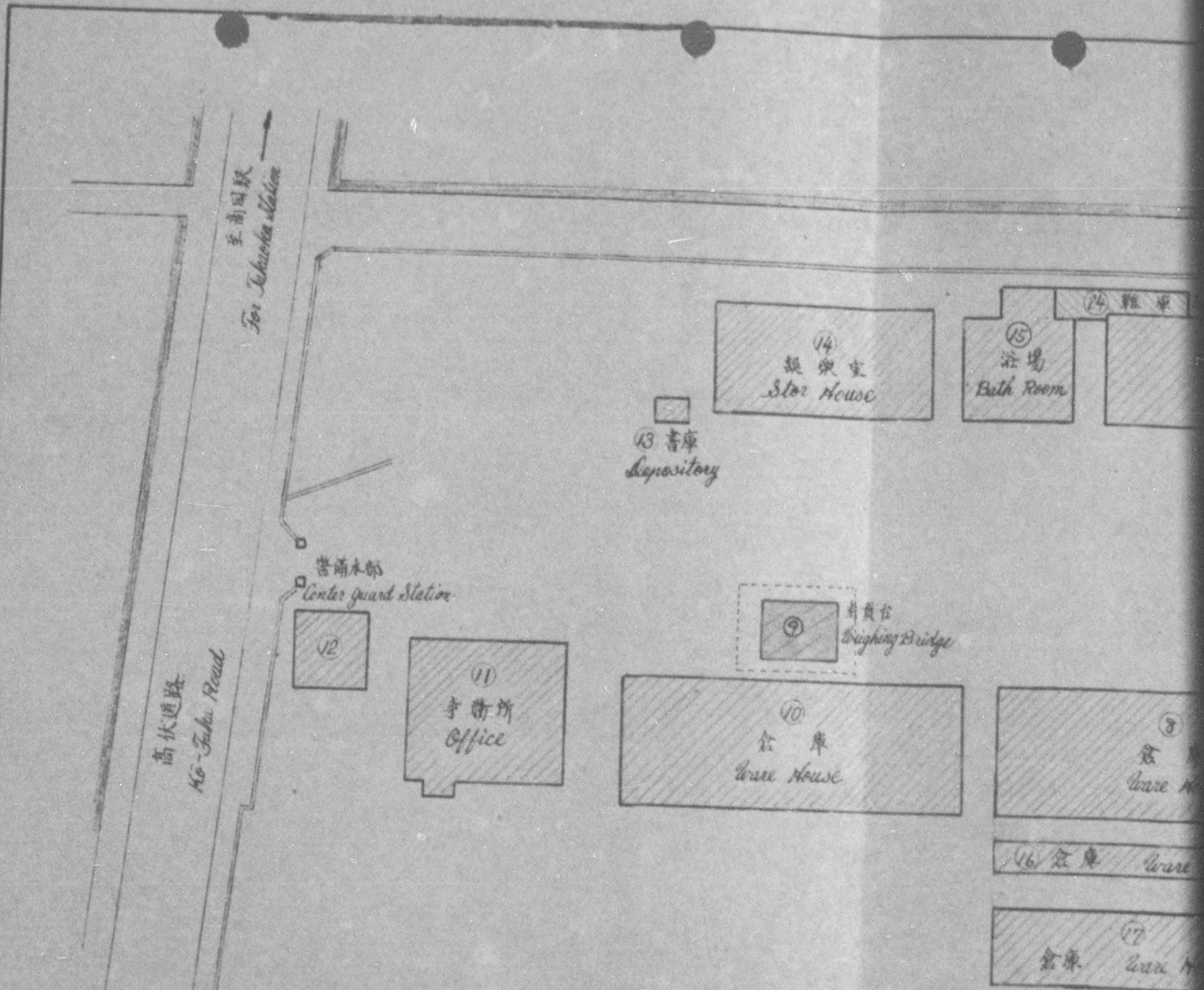

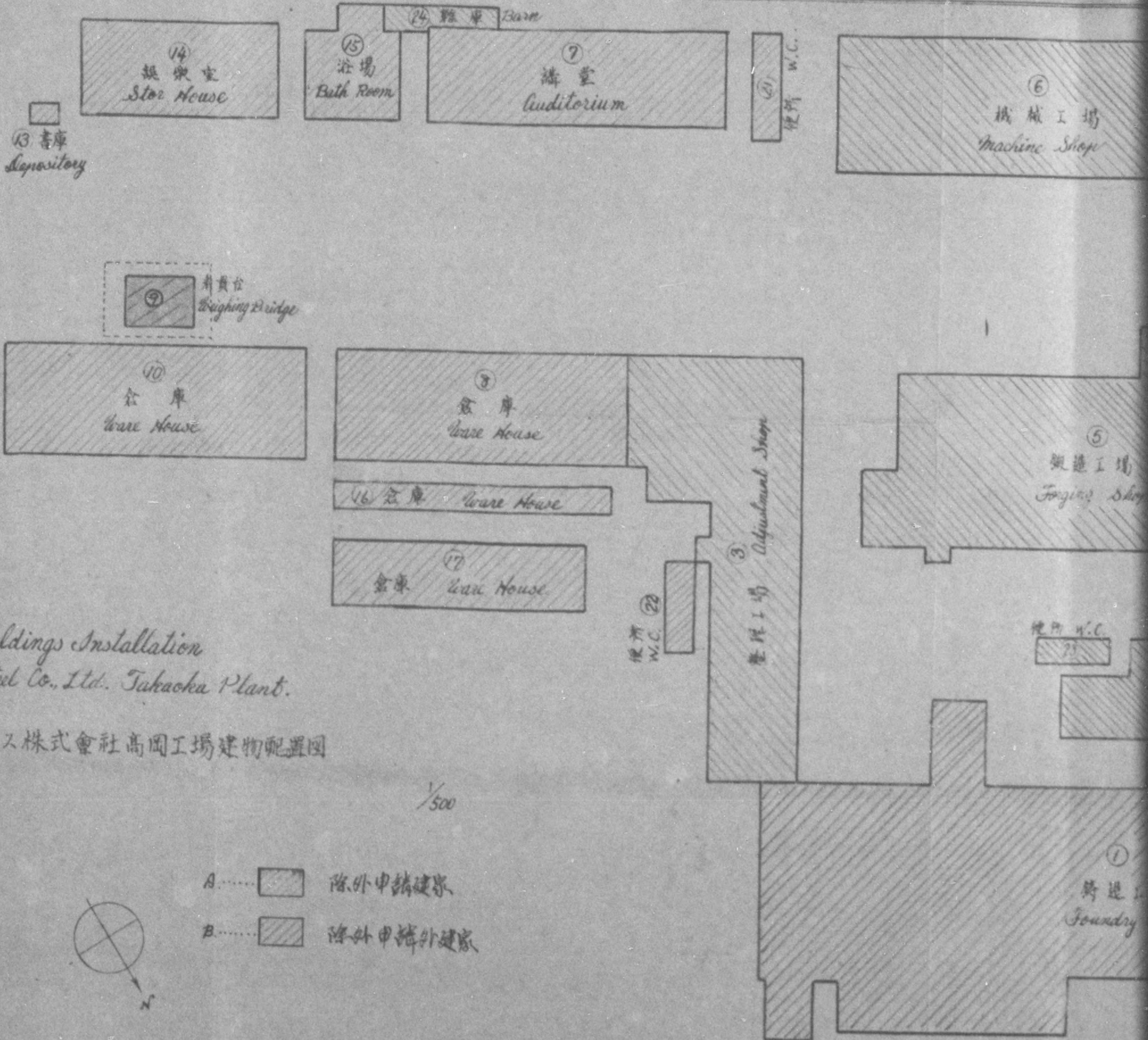

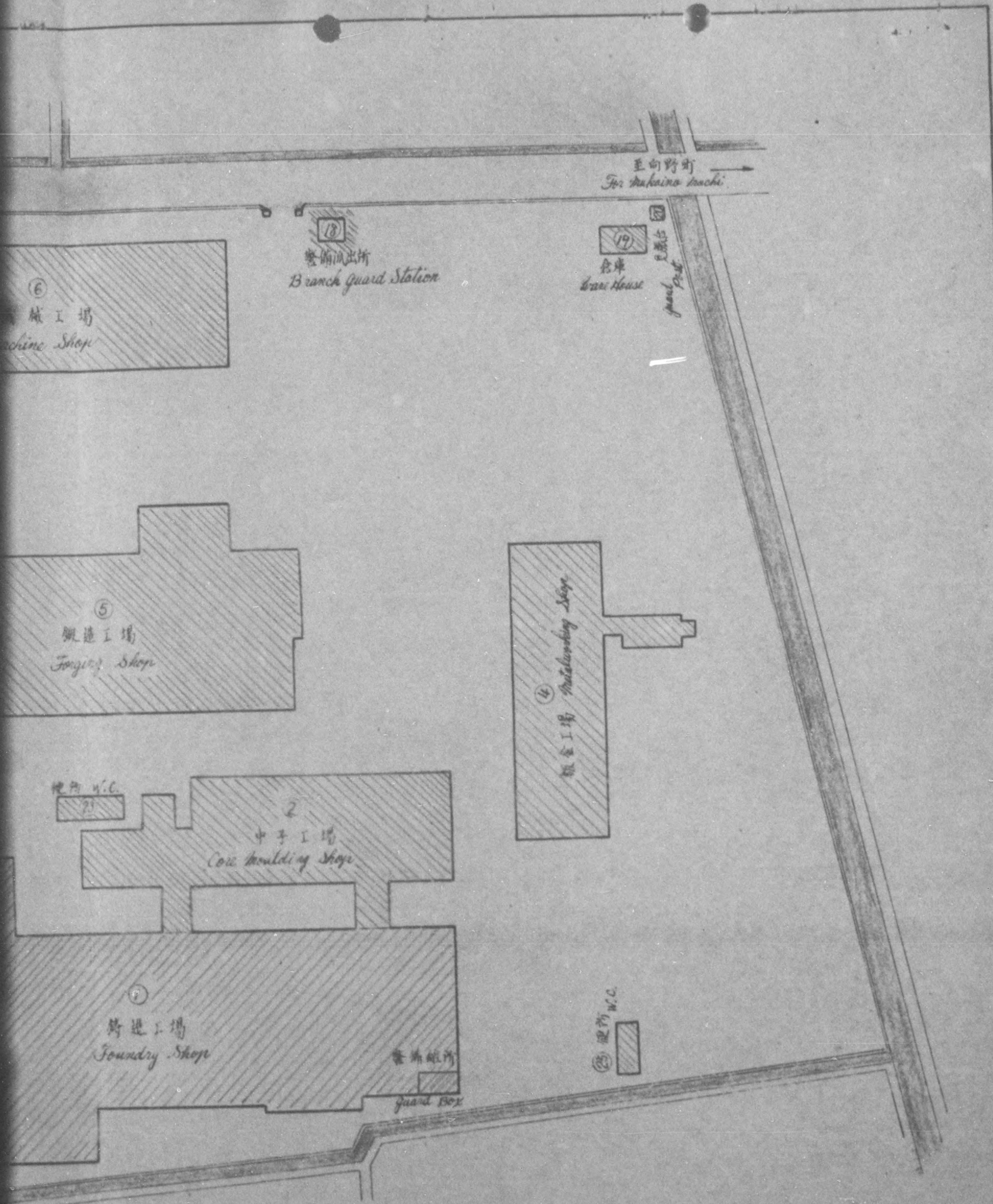

2. The Nippon Stainless Steel Co, Ltd, Takeoka Plant

3. The officials stated that due to financial diffi-
culties, and low market demand for their products, headquar-
ters believes that equipment designated for reparations, are
not necessairly important in the Japanese economy to the ex-
tent that other industrial plants are depending upon their
production.

4. In view of the facts that this plant ceased opera-
tions 8 March 1949, it is recommended that this plant be
