### MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministerial Ordinance concerning Special Rule for Land Ledger Law in accordance with the enforcement of Owner-Farmers Establishment Special Measures Law shall be defined as follows:

Article 1. Special Order regarding the registration in Land Ledger in accordance with Art. 44-2, Art. 44-3, Par. 1 of Owner-Farmer Establishment Special Measures Law (hereinafter called the Law) and Cabinet Order

No. 115 in 1948 (Cabinet Order governing to Special Order of Land Ledger Law in accordance with the enforcement of Owner-Farmers Establishment Special Measures Law), shall be effected by virtue of the provisions of this Ministerial Ordinance.

Article 2. In case when the Governor of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture intends to submit an application as prescribed in Arts. 18, 26, 40 or 41 of Land Ledger Law in place of a person who owns land or who holds the right of pledge or superficies in accordance with the provisions of Art. 44–3, Par. 1 of the Law, such effect must be stated on the said application.

Article 3. In regard to the registration of Land Ledger Law to the land acquired by the Government through purchase under the provisions of Art. 3, Art. 15 or Art. 40-2 of the law, exchange under the provisions of Art. 23 or purchase under the provisions of Art. 28, Par. 1 (including the cases when this shall be applied mutatis mutandis to Par. 5 of the same Article and Art. 41, Par. 4), the Land Ledger Law shall be applied exclusive of the provisions of Art. 10, Arts. 18 to 24 inclusive, Arts. 26 to 30 inclusive, Arts. 32 to 34 inclusive and Arts. 40 and 41 of Land Ledger Law.

Article 4. In case when purchase in accordance with the provisions of Arts. 3, 15, 30 Par. 1, 36, 37, or 40-2 of the Law, exchange under the provisions of Art. 23 and purchase under the provisions of Art. 28, Par. 1 (including the cases where this shall apply mutatis mutandis to Par. 5 of the same Article and Art. 41, Par. 4) shall be made, the concerned Agricultural Land Commission of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture or that of City, Town, Village must send to the Chief of the Tax Office in jurisdiction which is constituted in the location of the said land which is sold a notice in which the following is stated with regard to the land which pass purchase, change, of the said land:

- 1. Location of the land;
- 2. Lot number;
- 3. Kind;
- 4. Acreage:
- 5. Rental Value;
- 6. Location and name or title of the previous ownership of the land;
- 7. Other reference.

Article 5. In case where the land owned by the Government, to which the provisions of Art. 3 shall not be applied, is sold in accordance with the provisions of Art. 16 (including the provisions of Art. 16 (including the cases where this shall apply mutatis mutandis to

Art. 28, Pars. 4 and 5, Art. 29, Par. 2 and Art. 41, Par. 4 of the Law), Art. 28, Par. 3 (including the cases where this shall apply mutatis mutandis to Par. 5 of the same Article and Art. 41, Par. 4), Art. 41, Par. 1 or Art. 41–3, Par. 1, the concerned Agricultural land Commission of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or that of City, Town, Village must send to the Chief of the Tax Office in jurisdiction which is constituted in the location of the said land which is sold a notice in which the following is stated:

- 1. Location of the land;
- 2. Estimated lot number;
- 3. Kind;
- 4. Acreage;
- 5. Expected rental value; (In case the said land is located within any cultivated land adjustment area, the estimated rental value of the said land shall be determined under the actural condition at the time of commencement of the work.)
- 6. Location and name or title of a person to whom the land was sold;7. Date of sale.

Article 6. In case when the lands subjected to the provisions of Art. 3, during period when their ownership is in Government come under times as prescribed in Art. 18 or 31 of the Land Ledger Law or the said lands, when sold in accordance with provisions of Art. 16, Art. 23, Par. 3 (including cases of application mutatis mutandis of Par. 5 of the same Article and Art. 41, Par. 4. This holds in this Article hereinafter), or Art. 41 come under any category as prescribed in each item of Art. 27 of the Land Ledger Law, the concerned Agricultural Land Commission of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture, or that of City, Town or Village must send to the Chief of the Tax Office in jurisdiction which is constituted in the location of the said lands which is sold a notice in which such effect is stated.

Article 7. In the case of submittance of notifications prescribed in Art. 5 or the preceding Article, in which the difference between the acreage of lands transferred with that of the original lands or the division of lots of the lands is stated, the concerned Agricultural Commission of Metropplis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture or that of City, Town or Village is required to attach maps of surveyed acreage to the said notification

Article 8. Chief of Tax Office shall fix lot number, kind, acreage and rental value of the land in accordance with the notification,

when he receives such notification provided in Art. 5 or Art. 6.

In case the land which was stated in notification mentioned above paragraph is located within any cultivated land adjustment area the estimated rental value of the said land shall be determined under the actual condition at the time of commencement of the work.

Article 9. When cultivated land adjustment (including laying-out of land. This holds in this Article hereinafter.) is operated on such land to subject to the provisions of Art. 3, land substituted for the said land under Art. 30 of Cultivated Land Adjustment Law (including cases of application mutatis mutandis of Art. 12, Par. 2 of City Planning Law.

This holds in this Article hereinafter) shall be subject to the provisions of Art. 3.

When these are land subject to Art. 3 and other State owned land within Cultivated Land Adjustment Area which are to be given as substitution under the provisions of Art. 30 of Cultivated Land Adjustment Law, application of Art. 30, Par. 1 of Cultivated Land Adjustment Law shall be made to each substituted land.

Article 10. When land subject to the provisions of Art. 3 is considered proper to change purpose of use, or the same Article is considered not applicable by the concerned Agricultural Commission of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture or that of City, Town or Village or when the land purchased under the provisions of Art. 40-2 of Law is designated under the provisions of Par. 1, Art. 40-6 of Law, the concerned Agricultural Land Commission of Metropolis, Hokkaido, Special Prefecture or Prefecture or that of City, Town or Village must notify location, lot number, kind, acreage and rental value of the land to the Chief of the Tax Office in jurisdiction which is constituted in the location of the said lands.

The provisions of Art. 44 of Land Ledger Law shall be applied mutatis mutandis to this case from the day that the notification is delivered.

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall become effective as from the day of its promulgation.
