MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT:

Authorization for Direct Communication Between Japanese Government Board of Trade and Firms, Persons, and Foreign Missions on Commercial Matters.

1. References:

However, all contractual agreements including those concluded with foreign governments are subject to review and validation by or on behalf of the Supremo Commander for the Allied Powers.
