The Western Reserve of Ohio.

Our Ohio friends residing in California, will be interested in the compilation of a few facts touching the population and progress of the far-famed "Western Reserve." The average increase in the twelve counties comprising this district, to which politicians look with so much interest in an election canvass, is computed at thirty per cent., the whole number 309.875. The five principal towns in that section have increased rapidly. In 1830, Cleveland had a population of 1000 in 1840, 6071, and in 1850, 17,074. The agricultural portions of the northeastern part of the state, have increased but little. and the fact is explained as follows:-The people there are engaged chiefly in raising cattle and sheep, and find their profits in cheese, butter and wool. Such occupations require large farms. The number of the people grows but little, while their comforts and wealth increase very fast. The five counties of Ashtabula, Granger, Portage. Trumbull and Mahoning contain one-eighth of the cattle and one-ninth of the sheep in the whole state the number of sheep returned is 405,552, of cattle 145,890.

The Reserve contains 6000 square miles. The district was formerly known as "New Connecticut"-because its lands belonged to the state of Connecticut. It was reserved to that state in consequence of certain claims she set up to all the lands between her and the Pacific Ocean! This claim was founded on the original English charter, when they knew nothing of Western America, or whether there was such a place as Oregon and California in existence! It is possible, the English Ministry then thought that the Western Ocean run where the river Ohio does! Connecticut had also other claims for revolutionary sacrifices. Norwalk, Danbury and others of her towns had been burnt by the British under the lead of Tories. To the sufferers by these firs, a grant of half a million of acres, called the "Fire Lands," was made, in what is now the county of Hu-

Thus it happened, that the Western Reserve was chiefly settled by the Connecticut people, and the residue of its inhabitants were mostly from Massachusetts, New York and other northern states. It was by the sale of the state lands on the Western Reserve, that Connecticut created her school fund, now amounting to more than two millions of dollars. The Western Reserve has, in round numbers, 6,000 square miles-1000 more than old Connecticut. The census of Connecticut shows a population of 371,982. only one-sixth greater than that of the Reserve; and there is little doubt that the be contaminated with the destructive prinmother will soon see her daughter's prosperity far exceeding her own.

Whig Organization.

We have already published the proceedings of the Whig members of the Legislature held at San Jose on the 18th ult.. for the purpose of adopting a plan of organization of the party throughout the State. Suppression of Gambling in New York.

A strong effort is now being made in New York to suppress gambling in that city. An ssociation has been formed, and a very large meeting was held in the Tabernacle, to carry on the work. A report was made by the agent of the Society, which says, "we know that there are at least six thousand places in this city where gambling is privately and publicly allowed. This number, of course, includes places where games are played for rum, turkeys and money-ten pin alleys and billiard rooms, lottery and policy offices, fare rooms and cockpits arenas where dogs are fought and badgers baited, and a few of the shooting galleries and fashionable club rooms."

The report presented the cases of severa persons of high standing in society, who have een ruined by an indulgence of this vice. The eport also says that it pervades all classes in the community, and cites the following illusof the 'policy' business:

The mother we found on inquiry, to be a hard-working woman, of temperate habits, and addicted to no vice but her fatal propensity to policy gambling The father was intemperate, and spent all hi earnings for rum. SLAVERY IN THE STATES .- Pending hte election of a United States Senator in the Missouri Legislature, a letter was read from the Hon. H. S. Geyer, the candidate who subsequently was elected, in which he gives briefly his views upon the sectional questions which have agitated the country. He expresses the opinion that Congress does not possess any constitutional power to establish or prohibit slavery either in the Territories or District of Columbia. He thinks the passage of acts to prohibit slavery in the Territories or abolish it in the District, by the last Congress would have been regarded and treated by several of the States as an open declaration of civil war. Mr. Geyer approves of the adjustment made by Congress, which he thinks was the best settlement of the controversy that could, under all the circumstances, have been obtained.

An Indian was recently killed seven miles from those diggings. Two miners came in and reported that they had been attacked by the Indians. Money is scarce in the market, as it always must be to a certain extent in a country against which the balance of trade exists to such an amount as it does at the Sandwich Islands. The produce of the country before the California gold mines being only such fresh provisions and in such quantities as were sufficient to supply the whaleships resorting hither for recuits between their different cruises. Breaa—Is scarce and in good demand at our quotations. No importations the past month.

Flour—There are upwards of 6000 barrels, in first hands which are held at \$12; but the market is dull and we note the sales of three hundred and fifty-two quarter bags of Sydney flour, at auction, for \$2-35.
