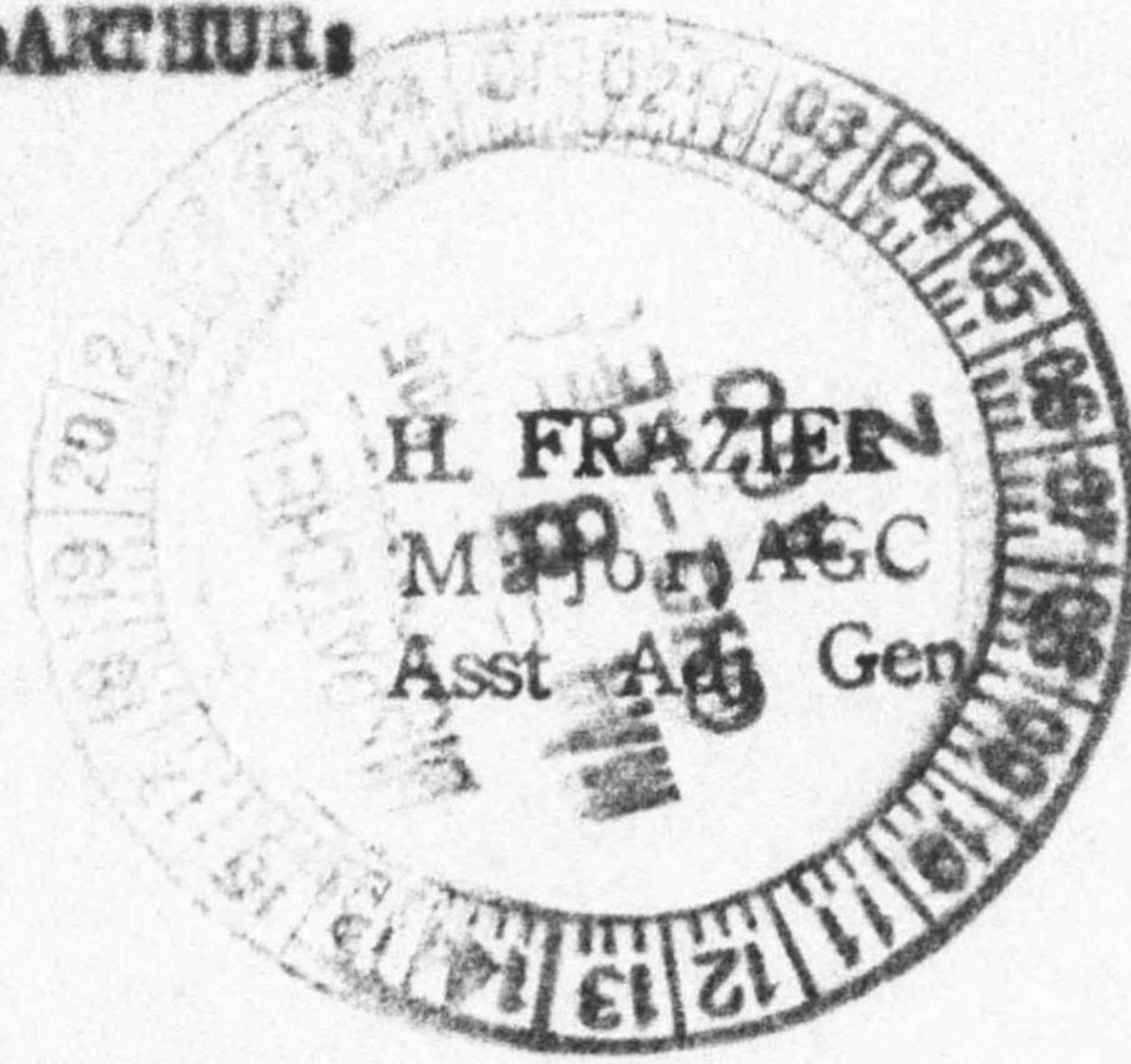

1. Reference is made to 2d Indorsement and inclosures thereto. As a result of the recent survey conducted by posts throughout the Kyushu region, it was found that many items originally charged to the Camp Kokura account, are actually located in other posts in the Kyushu area. Records of Kyushu Civil Affairs Region also showed numerous items in dead storage and some items released to other using agencies.

2.
