In accordance with the request of Capt. R. E. Swank through you, I wish to report as follows:-

The Customs are advised by the Chief of Maintenance and Administration Office, Kokura (ex Liaison Office) that all fixings and repairs must be done upon receipt of approval from the recipient Officer.

Under the circumstance, the Customs have been awaiting Capt. Swank's approval on copy of the annexed their statement dated 20th August 1947.

Since having received no approval, they are very anxious in getting of the same, and have asked Maj. Outland to have it through proper channel,

In the meantime, the Customs have partly done as follows;:

- 1) Repairing rag;- Completed on 22 Aug, 1947.
- 2) Fixing heaters;- Their plan is to fix 5 heaters (220v 2 kw). Not started yet, but it can be fixed within 5 days.
- 3) Repairing windows & applying paint;-  
The Customs thoroughly inspected and found that all sashes are not repairable therefore, they will be renewed. This work take 2 weeks (if weather permitting).
- 4 & 5) Cleaning windows & room;- Doing as ordered.
- 6) Curtain;- According to Capt. Swank's suggestion, The Customs tried to wash and repair, but it was in pieces, and renewing.
- 7) Broken parts of wall;- This will be repaired when renewing sash be
- 8) Repairing window in toilet;- It will/required when renewing sashes of the Office.
- 9) Repairing cokes & pipes in toilet; This work will be completed in a day or two.

Would you please pass the above on to Capt. Swank?
