MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry and Agriculture and Forestry
Ordinance No. 90

August 2, 1950

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 3 of the Law for the Fixed Number of Personnel in the Administrative Organs (Law No. 126 of 1949), the Ministerial Ordinance for Partial Amendments to the Regulations concerning the Fixed Number of Personnel of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry shall be established as follows:

Ministerial Ordinance for Partial Amendments to the Regulations concerning the Fixed Number of Personnel of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry

The Regulations concerning the Fixed Number of Personnel of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 81 of 1949) shall be partially amended as follows:

In the part of Internal Subdivisions in the table of Ministry Proper in paragraph 1, "675 persons" and "654 persons" in the personnel column for Agricultural Land Bureau, shall be amended as "583 persons" and "582 persons" respectively; and in the part of Local Branch Offices in the same table, "3,115 persons" and "3,086 persons" in the personnel column for Regional Agricultural Land Offices, shall be amended as "3,207 persons" and "3,178 persons" respectively.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The Attached Table No. 3 shall be partially amended as follows:

In Ibaragi Pref., "Ose-mura, Yasato-mura, Naga-kura-mura, Noguchi-mura and Iwama-machi, Minamikawane-mura, and Kitakawane-mura in Nishi-ibaragi-gun" shall be added under "Kanzaki-mura" under the jurisdiction of Mito Labor Standards Inspection Office; "(excluding the jurisdiction of Mito Labor Standards Inspection Office)" shall be added under "Nishi-ibaragi-gun" under the jurisdiction of Shimodate Labor Standards Inspection Office; "Tama-mura" shall be deleted; "Ose-mura, Yasato-mura, Nagakura-mura" and "Noguchi-mura" under the jurisdiction of Ota Labor Standards Inspection Office shall be deleted; and "Tama-mura" shall be added under "Iinuma-mura" under the jurisdiction of Mizukaido Labor Standards Inspection Office.

In Hyogo Pref., "Kakogawa City" shall be added before "Kako-gun" under the jurisdiction of Takasago Labor Standards Inspection Office.

In Kagoshima Pref., the appellation "Iwagawa" and location "Iwagawa-machi, Soo-gun" of Iwagawa Labor Standards Inspection Office shall be amended as "Shibushi" and "Shibushi-machi, Soogun" respectively.

NOTIFICATIONS

Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Notification No. 229

August 2, 1950

In accordance with the Regulations for Granting of Government Allotments and Subsidies (Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 41 of May 23, 1949), the Stipulations concerning Grant of Subsidy to Owner-farmer Establishment and Maintenance shall be prescribed as follows:

Minister of Agriculture and Forestry

Stipulations concerning Grant of Subsidy to Owner-farmer Establishment and Maintenance

Article 1. The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry shall, in accordance with the provisions of Article 16 of the Local Finance Law (Law No. 109 of 1948) and as is provided for in these Stipulations, grant to the To, Do, Fu and prefectures the subsidy as expenditure necessary for the owner-farmer establishment and maintenance business prescrided in Article 7 of the Agricultural Land Adjustment Law (Law No. 67 of 1938).

Article 2. The owner-farmer establishment and maintenance business prescribed in the preceding Article shall be the following kinds of business which are specified in the Ordinance concerning the Operation of Agricultural Land Adjustment Law (Imperial Ordinance No. 38 of 1946) and which shall be operated by such To, Do, Fu or prefecture, city, town, village, agricultural cooperative association, or the body composed of cultivators (hereinafter to be called as the city, town, village or others) as shall be designated by the Central Agricultural Land Commission, the To, Do, Fu or Prefecture Agricultural Land Commission or the City, Town or Village Agricultural Land Commission or Village Agricultural Land Commission:

- (1) Accommodation of the capital necessary either for the acquisition of prospective private owner-farmer lands or for the construction or acquisition of the facilities necessary for profitable use of owner-farmer lands to be established;
- (2) Accommodation of the capital necessary for liquidating and renewing the debt contracted by owner farmers.

Article 3. The expenditure provided for in Article 1 shall be as follows:

- (1) The expenditure of the To, Do, Fu or prefecture necessary for meeting the difference between the interest on the loan made in the interest of owner-farmer establishment and maintenance business and the interest on the capital accommodated;
- (2) The expenditure of the To, Do, Fu or prefecture necessary for supplementing the expenditure of the city, town or village to be appropriated for meeting the difference between the interest on the loan made in the interest of the business concerned and the interest on the capital accommodated.

Article 4. The amount of expenditure mentioned in the preceding Article shall be computed by means of the rate of subsidy specified in the Annex and in proportion to the original amount of capital accommodated.

Article 5. In the case where the debtor of the capital for owner-farmer establishment and maintenance has redeemed prematurely the unredeemed amount of loan to the To, Do, Fu or prefecture, the same To, Do, Fu or prefecture shall, as is provided for otherwise, submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry the report on premature redemption.

Article 6. The To, Do, Fu or prefecture, in case it intends, in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of the Regulations for Granting of Government Allotments and Subsidies (hereinafter to be called the Regulations), to apply for the grant of subsidy, shall submit to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry four original and duplicate copies of the written application, accompanied with the following documents:

- (1) Business plan;
- (2) Statement of estimated receipts and disbursements;
- (3) Stipulations concerning Grant of To, Do, Fu or Prefectural Subsidy as expenditure of the city, town, village, or others provided for in Article 3 item (2);
- (4) Other documents deemed necessary by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry.

Article 7. The To, Do, Fu or prefecture, in case it intends to introduce important alterations in the matters stated in any one of the documents specified in the preceding Article, shall inform beforehand the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry thereof.

2 In case he is informed as is provided for in the preceding paragraph the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may, if he deems it necessary to do so, instruct to work the necessary alterations in the reported matters specified in the same paragraph.

Article 8. The forms of the business plan and the statement of estimated receipts and disbursements to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of Article 6, and the form of the statement of business results and the statement of settled receipts and disbursements to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Regulations, shall be prescribed otherwise.

2 The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may ask the To, Do, Fu or prefecture concerned to submit to him the documents which he deems necessary, besides the statement of business results and the statement of settled receipts and disbursements.

Article 9. The To, Do, Fu or prefecture, in case it has caused the city, town or village redeem to it the expenditure specified in Article 3 item (2), shall inform without delay the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry thereof stating the reason therefor.

Supplementary Provision:

These Stipulations shall apply as from April 1,

1950; provided that with regard to the subsidy delivered prior to the enforcement of these Stipulations, the precedents under the former provisions shall apply.

Article 2. With motor vehicles transporting dangerous or inflammable articles of designated quantities or more, as well as motor vehicles served for passenger transport business with riding capacity of 10 persons or more, fire extinguishers shall be equipped. In this case, as to trailers transporting dangerous or in inflammable articles, or trailers transporting passengers, fire extinguishers shall be equipped with tractor, or tractor as well as trailer, respectively.
